On May 3, 2021 we had a brief video conference with [REDACTED] to discuss testifying at trial. The conversation was not substantive, and it was not an interview. However, during the conversation, [REDACTED] made two substantive remarks:

- [REDACTED] mentioned in passing that he thought we should interview [REDACTED]. We asked him why he thought we should interview her, and he said she was Maxwell's personal assistant, and that they're friends. I asked him if he had any specific information relating to her, or if he had learned anything since we last spoke with him and discussed [REDACTED], and he said no. [REDACTED] remarked that he is friends with [REDACTED], and that she is having a hard time right now emotionally, especially given the press coverage.
