- During the 2005 PBPD investigation of Epstein, [REDACTED] went with [REDACTED] on interviews. [REDACTED] was the lead handling the investigation, and [REDACTED] would go as backup a lot just to be there with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was not part of any trash searches.
- Other than the one supplement regarding the search that [REDACTED] wrote, [REDACTED] does not recall writing any reports or taking any notes.
- [REDACTED] participated in October 20, 2005 search of JE house, and went through the house with Det. [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] reviewed supplement reports by [REDACTED] & [REDACTED] to refresh his recollection of the search. [REDACTED] recalls:
  - [REDACTED] & [REDACTED] went into main house to conduct search
  - Started in garage
  - Went through each room with fine tooth comb
  - Remembers seeing the phone message book that [REDACTED] pointed out to him. Stands out in his mind because that was the type of evidence they were looking for – were trying to find documents like that. Doesn't remember what was on the book or what it looked like.
  - Detectives would point evidence out, then crime scene unit would put each item into evidence. [REDACTED] believes [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were the CSU team that day. Believes [REDACTED] videotaped, [REDACTED] collected, [REDACTED] logged evidence.
  - Epstein's house stands out in [REDACTED] mind, recalls lots of photographs of young women.
  - Believes reviewing photographs/videos would help refresh recollection and bring back more details.
