- Government sent GG the Loftus expert notice and a revised draft
- She contacted [REDACTED] (from list of prior testimony). GG will send us a revised list of prior testimony.
- When people have conversed with others, it can help memory be more accurate
- Initial denial of CSA is not uncommon for children who have been sexually trafficked/don't trust authorities/have been told not to tell.
 - Sexually trafficked victims in this context are usually teenagers
 - Other results are common for 7 yo to adolescents (13-17 or so – under 18, though sometimes starts at 12). Older kids were a combination of sex abuse/physical abuse/neglect cases.
- Other researchers use similar methods to Loftus
