- Has been with the DMV for 20 years
- Supervising investigator: conduct crim investigations involving the DMV; supervises other investigators
- [REDACTED]
- Compass: DMV database
- To get ID card, people fill out form
- DMV verifies name and DOB.
- [REDACTED] The original application records are destroyed, so can't say what she provided at the time, but can say the types of IDs that would have been accepted to prove DOB.
 - Verify name, DOB, original social security card, some proof of residency. DMV examines security features
 - Certain documents are ok to prove DOB, like passport
- Employee takes photo after documents are verified
- Once someone has an ID card, can return, take a permit test and written test, then complete a course, then do a road test, and then get a driver's license

- Real ID: individual can travel domestically using a state DL
 - To get, you have to provide original documents for original social security card, original passport, original birth certificate/naturalization certificate, etc.
 - Have to provide originals even if already have a regular DL
 - Thinks they take a new photo, but may rely on one in the system
