Pursuant to our conversation a few minutes ago, the affiant Agent and I have made the following revisions to the application and affidavit referenced below.

With respect to the location of the taxidermied dog, the prior application included the sentence:

Inside the Subject Premises, in what appears to be EPSTEIN's office, on or about the second floor of the Subject Premises, I observed what appears to be a taxidermied dog (the "Dog").

That has been revised as follows:

Inside the Subject Premises, in what appears to be EPSTEIN's office, on or about the second floor of the Subject Premises, I observed what appears to be a taxidermied dog (the "Dog").

Separately, the Rider of the warrant now reflects the following language in the "Items to be Seized" section:

- i. Any and all taxidermied dogs.
- ii. Any and all massage tables and massage paraphernalia.
- iii. Any and all busts or three-dimensional representations of female human torsos.
- iv. Any and all photos or representations depicting nude or partially nude women located in the Massage Room, as defined herein.
- v. Any and all sex toys and paraphernalia located in the Massage Room, as defined herein.
- vi. A binder labeled "PB Girls" and any other documents or communications with or regarding victims or potential victims of the Subject Offenses.

If that accurately reflects your modifications, I will send the entirety of the documents immediately.
