





### **Epstein Victim Explains Why She's Suing FBI After Agency Ignored Her Claims for 10 Years**

The [Washington Examiner](#) (07/25, Notheis) reported that ██████████ a victim of Jeffrey Epstein who is suing the FBI, explained on Monday that she is suing the agency for ignoring her case for a decade. The article added that ██████████, who was Epstein's first victim to go to the authorities regarding the sex offender, is one of two plaintiffs who are suing the FBI over the agency's failure to investigate Epstein. ██████████ attorney, Jennifer Freeman, explained that they are in the process of getting a notice of claim, also known as a precursor, filed with the FBI. The article noted that ██████████ explained that when she was working for Epstein in 1996, she had been asked to give a foot massage to Epstein while he was watching a math

program on television. She was then directed by the New York Police Department to call the FBI, and she discussed with an FBI agent for 45 minutes that she had been kidnapped.
