


















### **Ghislaine Maxwell's Brother Defends Prince Andrew, Says FBI Ignored Accuser's Evidence**

[Newsweek](#) (11/22, Royston) reported that Ghislaine Maxwell's brother, Ian Maxwell, defended Prince Andrew from Jeffrey Epstein's sex abuse allegations and took a swipe at the royal's accuser, ██████████, in an interview on BBC Radio 4. According to the article, Ghislaine Maxwell is Epstein's former lover and accused of grooming underage girls for the New York financier to abuse between 1994 and 2004, which she denies. The article noted that ██████████ accused Andrew of rape and intentionally inflicting emotional distress. "You have a situation where one

of the most vociferous accusers, a lady called [REDACTED], has decided to pursue Andrew in spades. But what's interesting about that particular accuser, who as I think I said is perhaps the best known and most vociferous, is that she is not one of the accusers at my sister's trial. And I think that's very significant because had she had evidence that the U.S. authorities believed could be stood up at trial then surely they would have used that evidence," Ian Maxwell stated.
