"Preserving the innocence of children is one of the most important, if not the most important, responsibilities we carry as adults. Jeffery Epstein, and Ms. Maxwell chose to blatantly disregard this responsibility. As alleged in the indictment, Ms. Maxwell used whatever means at her disposal to lure children into a life to which they should never be exposed.
