Hello CDC [REDACTED], ADC [REDACTED], and SA [REDACTED];

I have received a request for EPSTEIN, Jeffrey (DOB 1/20/1953; SSN 090-44-3348) and through an ACS search, file 72-MM-113327 was found to be a main file on the subject. However, the file is still in a pending status.

If you would, please answer the following questions so I may proceed accordingly.

1. Is the investigation pending, and why, i.e., trial is pending, an appeal from the trial is pending, awaiting U.S. Attorney decision to prosecute, etc.?
2. Can we advise the requester that the investigation is pending?
- 2a. If we advise the requester of the pending status will this jeopardize your investigation?
3. Is there any public source material contained in the investigative file?
4. Has the subject been interviewed?

Application of B7A (law enforcement exemption) will only apply as long as the investigation is pending. However, once the case is no longer pending additional exemptions may be applied to third party privacy, classified, and all other sensitive information, as appropriate.
