If you prefer to simply turn over the equipment without anyone appearing before the grand jury that is fine. If we proceed that way, we can defer litigating the issue of the applicability of the attorney-client and/or work product privilege to information related to how and why the equipment was removed. I will be in trial this week, so please contact [REDACTED] at the FBI directly at [REDACTED].

I look forward to your July 11th submission. If you would like to discuss the possibility of a federal resolution of Mr. Epstein's case that could run concurrently with any state resolution, please leave a message on my voicemail at the office ([REDACTED]) and I will get back to you after trial has ended for the day.
