

Colleagues,

The district court has entered a fourteen-page order granting in part the victims' petition to enforce rights under the CVRA. The Court finds that CVRA rights attach prior to the filing of a formal charge. The Court also found that issues regarding whether the United States exerted its best efforts need to be developed before the Court could make its determination. The Court granted limited discovery to the victims, in the form of requests for admissions and requests for production.
