Re Kathy's question to me on the bottom of the email [REDACTED] and her father were the only ones that described any recent allegations of being contacted by Epstein's attorneys or investigators. [REDACTED] did state that Epstein's attorneys or investigators tried to contact her (2 of them together) in person 3 separate times. They showed up unannounced and tried to speak with her. Her husband was present at least one of those times and he had been unaware of any incident up until Epstein's people started showing up. They found her though she changed her last name and address (and per [REDACTED] even the FBI could not find her). I did not note nor do I remember the specifics re when she said it happened, but I understood that it was a long time ago (prior to his plea this summer).

I am very appreciative of you taking the time to meet with us and for all that you have done for these plaintiffs. Take care.

Hi [REDACTED] We, too, enjoyed lunch and are so proud to know you. I told Bob and Amy that I wanted to nominate you for an award for your courage and determination to fight for these victims. It's a shame we all have to keep everything confidential. Just know privately how much I admire and thank you!

There are a couple of victims to whom I spoke who never called back. One was [REDACTED] a client of Randee Speciale, I believe, who actually attempted suicide after her encounter (s) with JE. She simply responded to what I told her by phone with an "I'll think about it." The other victim who didn't call back was [REDACTED], who lives in [REDACTED]. She was very positive, wanted to fly down for a visit with her best friend; thought she would be able to get away because her new husband had just deployed in the Navy. Said she would definitely get back to me within a few days. Her numbers are [REDACTED] (cell) and [REDACTED]. We have not heard back from [REDACTED] yet, although we thought the interview with her just before we saw you went well.

It was [REDACTED] who thought that she had been contacted by Epstein's investigators. Her father also was on the call. It was not a number that showed up on their receiver. I may be wrong, but I think [REDACTED] may also have been contacted in person. (Amy, do you recall that?)
