We have sent interrogatories, requests for production and requests for admissions and he has taken the 5th on everything. He won't give us one name of any possible witnesses and not one single document. In fact, I have him set for deposition but we have already been told that he is only answering his name and current address and taking the 5th on everything else. So, please, let me know what, if anything else, I need to do to make a FOIA request for the video. Thanks
