Dear Adriana Le,

I am contacting you in regards and concern of an appointment held with you at your visiting Clare practice on the 31st January 2022, following a referral by Dr Richard Daehn, Kadina Medical Association, dated 16th December 2021, stating

- Explore this further to ascertain whether she can actually have a Covid-19 vaccine, or whether she needs a Medical Exemption
- Suffered Anaphylaxis to a flu vaccine in 2014 - Severe Allergy reaction to previous vaccines
Medical history of patient
- Respiratory symptoms following an ADT vaccine in August 2020 - Allergy Asthma / Allergy reaction to a vaccine resulting in ongoing medical condition to previous vaccines
Medical History
- Suffered severe reactions to several medications previously - Highly sensitive to medications
Immune system sensitivity - Medical History
- Concerned about having a serious reaction to Covid-19 vaccine - Suffered previous serious Allergy reactions to vaccines and medications resulting in ongoing medical conditions and Immune system complications - Medical History

Considering this information provided to you by the referring doctor, Dr Richard Daehn, Kadina Medical Association and his request for further investigation / testing of his patient for a susceptible allergy reaction concerning the medical history of his patient involved and a medical history of previous severe allergy reactions to more than one vaccine, stipulated on the referral by Dr Richard Daehn, Kadina Medical Association you failed to conduct a correct Medical assessment according to the referral by not conducting testing of the patient to ascertain the affects of then advising your patient to proceed with the administration of the Covid-19 vaccine, Pfizer, and referred your patient to the Royal Adelaide Hospital Specialist Vaccination Clinic, without a proper and correct medical assessment being conducted to ascertain an Allergy reaction to the vaccine.

On your Professional Medical advice your patient, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] proceeded to attend the appointment made for her on the 8th February 2022 at the Royal Adelaide Hospital Specialist Vaccination Clinic, and proceeded with the administration of the Covid-19 vaccine, Pfizer, based solely on your Professional medical advice, and without a correct medical procedure of conducting testing for an Allergy reaction to the vaccine and according to the medical history of the patient referred to you by Dr Richard Daehn, Kadina Medical association stipulating that his patient had suffered numerous allergy reactions to vaccines and medications previously, which indicates an extremely sensitive Immune system to medications. As a result of your failure to conduct a correct medical assessment of your patient by

conducting testing to ascertain if your patient would be susceptible to developing an Allergy reaction to the vaccine based on her Medical History and providing your Professional Medical advice without conducting the proper medical Procedure the patient on your Professional Medical advice proceeded with the administration of the Covid-19 , Pfizer vaccination which resulted in your referred patient, [REDACTED] suffering an Extreme Acute Allergy reaction following the administration of the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine, which resulted in emergency treatment in an Emergency ward of the Wallaroo Hospital on the 23rd February 2021, and was diagnosed as Acute Allergy Oedema as a result of the administration of the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine, administered on the 8th February 2022, on your advice.

According to the patient information pamphlet received by your patient, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] supplied to her by the Royal Adelaide Hospital Specialist Vaccine Clinic following the administration of the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine, the patient information supplied to her states :

- Pfizer immunisation vaccine should not be administered if suffered previous allergy reactions to previous immunisations / vaccines - Common medical knowledge and supplied to the patient - Knowledge in your possession considering your position as an Allergist of the Royal Adelaide Hospital

I have currently been in contact with two solicitors concerning the conduct of your Medical Negligence, including Doug Reed, Kadina, who advised me to contact Johnston Withers, Matthew Windsor.

On the advice of Solicitor Matthew Windsor of the reported case of your Medical Negligence which resulted in an Acute Allergy reaction to the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine I am contacting you to submit a claim of Medical Negligence against you of an out of court settlement of a monetary value and not a prosecution against you concerning :

- Not conducting testing on a referred patient and based on a referral of a medical history of previous severe acute allergy reactions to previous vaccines and medications
- Providing negligent Professional medical advice to the referred patient without conducting a correct and proper medical procedure and medical assessment to ascertain the susceptibility of the patient of developing a allergy reaction to the vaccine, based on the referral resulting in the endangerment of your referred patients life and pain and suffering as a result
- Not adhering to correct Medical procedures and concerning the information provided in the patient information pamphlet of the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine, as provided to the patient by the Royal Adelaide Hospital Specialist Vaccine Clinic, and your knowledge concerning the patient information considering your position as an Allergist at the Royal Adelaide Hospital and the effects of the Pfizer vaccine information regarding Do not administer if suffered previous allergy reactions to previous vaccines, and as stated and stipulated in your referred patients medical history in the referral by Dr Richard Daehn, Kadina Medical Association as suffering from Acute Allergy Reactions to previous vaccines and medications
- Pain and suffering of your referred patient as a result of your Medical negligence for a duration to the patient of 2 months, requiring emergency treatment
- Ongoing medical complications and conditions as a result of your Medical Negligence and your referred patient suffering from Acute Allergy Oedema, as result of adhering to your Medical Professional advice, and without a proper correct medical assessment to ascertain her susceptibility to the vaccine Covid-19 Pfizer
- Loss of 2 months employment and work capacity to the referred patient as a result of your Medical Negligence resulting in Acute Allergy Oedema to the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine
- Compromised care and endangerment of your referred patients parents who are currently suffering from Terminal illnesses that require regular treatment in Metropolitan locations and locations outside of the region of residence as their legal carer and is responsible to provide care, as a result of your Medical Negligence resulting your referred patient suffering from Acute Allergy Oedema over a 2 month period

I am contacting you to inform you of my intention of this monetary claim of Medical Negligence conducted by you and my intention of settling this claim and this matter in an out of court settlement of a monetary value and claim against your practice and insurer, concerning the stated and stipulated information provided in this contact, and am seeking to commence negotiations of a monetary value concerning this matter within a period of 30 days following you receiving this notification, and am giving you 30 days to respond.

I am informing you that if you , the doctor and I, the patient can not come to an agreement regarding this matter I do intend to go public and publish the Medical Negligence of your Medical Profession and practice, and also that of the Royal Adelaide Hospital Specialist Vaccination Clinic, and their included involvement in the Medical Negligence resulting in Acute Allergy Oedema, severe pain and suffering and the Endangerment to my life, as a result of the administered Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine and the Government Immunisation Scheme.

I have provided all documented evidence to support my claim and will wait for your contact and reply regarding this matter and claim.

Dear Lesley Dwyer CEO,

I am contacting you in regards and concern of an appointment held on the 8th February 2022 in the Royal Adelaide Hospital Specialist Vaccination Clinic, concerning the vaccination of the Covid-19, Pfizer vaccine.

I attended an appointment prior with Dr Adriana Le, Immunologist / Allergist on the 31st January 2022 under the referral by Dr Richard Daehn, Kadina Medical Association, dated 16th December 2021, in concern of the danger to his patients health regarding an extensive medical history of his patient of severe acute allergy reactions to vaccines and medications.

The referral stated :

- Explore this further to ascertain whether she can actually have a Covid-19 vaccine, or whether she needs a Medical Exemption
- Suffered Anaphylaxis to a flu vaccine in 2014 - Severe Allergy reaction to previous vaccines
Medical history of patient
- Respiratory symptoms following an ADT vaccine in August 2020 - Allergy Asthma / Allergy reaction to a vaccine resulting in ongoing medical condition to previous vaccines
Medical History
- Suffered severe reactions to several medications previously - Highly sensitive to medications
Immune system sensitivity - Medical History
- Concerned about having a serious reaction to Covid-19 vaccine - Suffered previous serious Allergy reactions to vaccines and medications resulting in ongoing medical conditions and Immune system complications - Medical History

Considering this information provided to Dr Adriana Le, Immunologist / Allergist by the referring doctor, Dr Richard Daehn, Kadina Medical Association and his request for further investigation / testing of his patient for a susceptible allergy reaction concerning the medical history of his patient involved and a medical history of previous severe allergy reactions to more than one vaccine, stipulated on the referral by Dr Richard Daehn, Kadina Medical Association Dr Adriana Le failed to conduct a correct Medical assessment according to the referral by not conducting testing of the patient to ascertain the affects of then advising your patient to proceed with the administration of the Covid-19 vaccine, Pfizer, and referred her patient to the Royal Adelaide Hospital Specialist Vaccination Clinic, without a proper and correct medical assessment being conducted to ascertain an Allergy reaction to the vaccine, and provided this information to the Royal Adelaide Hospital Specialist Vaccination Clinic when referring her patient for the appointment made on the 8th February 2022.

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On Dr Adriana Le, Immunologist / Allergist Professional Medical advice to her patient, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] proceeded to attend the appointment made for her on the 8th February 2022 at the Royal Adelaide Hospital Specialist Vaccination Clinic, and proceeded with the administration of the Covid-19 vaccine, Pfizer, based solely on Dr Adriana Le, Immunologist / Allergist Professional medical advice, and without Dr Adriana Le, Immunologist / Allergist conducting a correct medical procedure of conducting testing for an Allergy reaction to the vaccine and according to the medical history of the patient referred to her by Dr Richard Daehn, Kadina Medical association stipulating that his patient had suffered numerous allergy reactions to vaccines and medications previously, which indicates an extremely sensitive Immune system to medications.

On this referral made by Dr Adrian Le, Immunologist / Allergist I, the patient attended the appointment at the Royal Adelaide Hospital Specialist Vaccination Clinic on the 8th February 2022, date of first dose of the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine to be administered.

During this attended appointment and prior to the vaccine being administered I, the patient was assessed by the attending Allergist of the Specialist Vaccination Clinic in consideration and concern of my, the patients Medical History of extensive Acute Allergy Reactions to previous vaccines and medications. During the assessment by the attending Allergist of the Specialist Vaccination Clinic the assessing Allergist stated when informed by the patient of a previous allergy reaction to a specific medication, "That's cause for concern", but proceeded to advise the patient to proceed with the administration of the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine, first dose, without conducting further investigation of a proper and correct medical procedure of testing the patient for susceptibility of an Allergy reaction occurring as a result of administration of the vaccine.

The Specialist Vaccination Clinic of the Royal Adelaide Hospital was knowledgeable and aware of my, the patients Medical history of extensive Acute Allergy Reactions to previous vaccines and several medications and was the sole reason the patient was assessed by the attending Allergist prior to the vaccine being administered.

Following the incorrect medical procedure of proceeding with the administration of the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine I, the patient was observed and monitored for an extended period of 45 minutes by the Specialist Vaccination Clinic, as a result of their knowledge and awareness of the patients medical history of Extensive Acute Allergy reactions to previous vaccines and medications.

As a result of failure to conduct correct medical assessments and procedures of the patient and advising the patient to proceed with the administration of the first dose of the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine the patient suffered an Acute Allergy Reaction, which resulted in Emergency treatment at the Wallaroo Hospital Emergency ward, and was diagnosed with Acute Allergy Oedema as a result of the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine, which had resulted in extensive medical complications, which included a Compromised Respiratory System, which had escalated to the point of Rapid Breathing and endangerment to the patients life.

According to the patients information pamphlet received by the patient of the Specialist Vaccination Clinic of the Royal Adelaide Hospital following the administration of the first dose of the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine, the patient information supplied to her stated :

- Pfizer immunisation vaccine should not be administered if suffered previous allergy reactions or respiratory reactions to previous immunisations / vaccines - Common medical knowledge of the Specialist Vaccination Clinic of the Royal Adelaide Hospital and supplied to the patient

Contained within the Medical History of the patient referred to the Specialist Vaccination Clinic of the Royal Adelaide Hospital states, Patient has previous medical history of suffering from Anaphylaxis to Flu vaccine in 2014 and suffered from Respiratory symptoms following ADT vaccine in August 2020, a clear and precise medical history of previous Allergy reactions and respiratory reactions to previous vaccines.

I have currently been in contact with two solicitors concerning the conduct of the Medical Negligence conducted by the Specialist Vaccination Clinic of the Royal Adelaide Hospital, including Doug Reed, Kadina, who advised me to contact Johnston Withers, Matthew Windsor.

On the advice of Solicitor Matthew Windsor of the reported case of your Medical Negligence which resulted in an Acute Allergy reaction to the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine I am contacting you to submit a claim of Medical Negligence against the Specialist Vaccination Clinic of the Royal Adelaide Hospital and the Attending Allergist of an out of court settlement of a monetary value and not a prosecution against the parties involved concerning :

- Not conducting testing on a referred patient and based on a referral of a medical history of previous severe acute allergy reactions to previous vaccines and medications - Medical Negligence
- Providing negligent Professional medical advice to the referred patient without conducting a correct and proper medical procedure and medical assessment to ascertain the susceptibility of the patient of developing a allergy reaction to the vaccine, based on the referral resulting in the endangerment of your referred patients life and pain and suffering as a result - Medical Negligence
- Not adhering to correct Medical procedures and concerning the information provided in the patient information pamphlet of the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine, as provided to the patient by the Royal Adelaide Hospital Specialist Vaccine Clinic, and your knowledge concerning the patient information considering your position as an Allergist at the Royal Adelaide Hospital and the effects of the Pfizer vaccine information regarding Do not administer if suffered previous allergy reactions to previous vaccines, and as stated and stipulated in your referred patients medical history in the referral by Dr Richard Daehn, Kadina Medical Association as suffering from Acute Allergy Reactions to previous vaccines and medications and medical information provided by Dr Adriana Le, Immunologist / Allergist - Medical Negligence
- Proceeding to administer the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine with the knowledge of the patients medical history of previous allergy reactions and respiratory reactions to previous vaccines, which resulted in the endangerment to the patients life and Acute Allergy Oedema as a result of Medical Negligence
- Pain and suffering of your referred patient as a result of your Medical negligence for a duration to the patient of 2 months, requiring emergency treatment
- Ongoing medical complications and conditions as a result of your Medical Negligence and your referred patient suffering from Acute Allergy Oedema, as result of adhering to your Medical Professional advice, and without a proper correct medical assessment to ascertain her susceptibility to the vaccine Covid-19 Pfizer
- Loss of 2 months employment and work capacity to the referred patient as a result of your Medical Negligence resulting in Acute Allergy Oedema to the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine
