Jeffrey Epstein

Jeffrey Edward Epstein (/ˈɛpstiːn/ *EP-steen*,^[2] January 20, 1953 – August 10, 2019) was an American financier and convicted sex offender.^{[3][4]} Epstein, who was born and raised in Brooklyn, New York City, began his professional life by teaching at the Dalton School in Manhattan, despite lacking a college degree. After his dismissal from the school, he entered the banking and finance sector, working at Bear Stearns in various roles; he eventually started his own firm. Epstein developed an elite social circle and procured many women and children; he and some of his associates then sexually abused them.^{[5][4][6][7]}

In 2005, police in Palm Beach, Florida, began investigating Epstein after a parent complained that he had sexually abused her 14-year-old daughter.^[8] Epstein pleaded guilty and was convicted in 2008 by a Florida state court of procuring a child for prostitution and of soliciting a prostitute.^{[5][9]} He served almost 13 months in custody, but with extensive work release. He was convicted of only these two crimes as part of a controversial plea deal; federal officials had identified 36 girls, some as young as 14 years old, whom Epstein had allegedly sexually abused.^{[1][10]}


Epstein was arrested again on July 6, 2019, on federal charges for the sex trafficking of minors in Florida and New York.^{[11][12]} He died in his jail cell on August 10, 2019.^[13] The medical examiner ruled the death a suicide.^[14] Epstein's lawyers have disputed the ruling, and there has been significant public skepticism about the true cause of his death, resulting in numerous conspiracy theories.^{[15][16]} Since Epstein's death precluded the possibility of pursuing criminal charges against him, a judge dismissed all criminal charges on August 29, 2019.^{[17][18]} Epstein had a decades-long association with the British socialite Ghislaine Maxwell, leading to her 2021 conviction on U.S. federal charges of sex trafficking and conspiracy for helping him procure girls, including a 14-year-old, for child sexual abuse and prostitution.^{[19][20][21][22]} Epstein also maintained long-term relationships with various high-profile individuals, including Donald Trump, Leslie Wexner, Bill Clinton, Alan Dershowitz, and Prince Andrew, Duke of York.^[23]

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY THEFT 1993-2021 - DESTRUCTION OF CAREER PROSPECTS

Details of a civil lawsuit, made public in January 2015, contained a deposition from "Jane Doe 3" that accused Maxwell of recruiting her in 1999, when she was a minor, and grooming her to provide sexual services for Epstein.^[22] A 2018 exposé by Julie K. Brown in the *Miami Herald* revealed Jane Doe 3 to be ██████████, who was previously known as ██████████. ██████████ met Maxwell at Donald Trump's Mar-a-Lago Club in Palm Beach, Florida, when ██████████ was a 16-year-old spa attendant.^[22] She asserted that Maxwell had introduced her to Epstein, after which she was "groomed by the two [of them] for his pleasure, including lessons in Epstein's preferences during oral sex".^{[22][63]}

Maxwell has repeatedly denied any involvement in Epstein's crimes.^[51] In a 2015 statement, Maxwell rejected allegations that she has acted as a procurer for Epstein and denied that she had "facilitated Prince Andrew's [alleged] acts of sexual abuse". Her spokesperson said "the allegations made against Ghislaine Maxwell are untrue" and she "strongly denies allegations of an unsavoury nature, which have appeared in the British press and elsewhere, and reserves her right to seek redress at the repetition of such old defamatory claims".^{[58][64]}

██████████ asserted that Maxwell and Epstein had trafficked her and other underage girls, often at sex parties hosted by Epstein at his homes in New York, New Mexico, Palm Beach, and the United States Virgin Islands. Maxwell called her a liar. ██████████ sued Maxwell for defamation in federal court in the Southern District of New York in 2015. While details of the settlement have not been made public, in May 2017 the case was settled in ██████████ favour,^[65] with Maxwell paying ██████████ "millions".^[66]

MAXWELL DESTRUCTION OF CAREER PROSPECTS - COMPLY.

In 2017, ██████████ filed a suit, in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, against Epstein and Maxwell, alleging that Maxwell hired her to give massages to Epstein and later threatened to physically harm her or destroy her career prospects if she did not comply with their sexual demands at his mansion in New York and on his private Caribbean island, Little Saint James. The suit was settled in 2018 under undisclosed terms.^{[9][48][67][68]}

Affidavit filed by ██████████ (2019)


On 16 April 2019, ██████████ went public and filed a sworn affidavit in federal court in New York, alleging that she and her 15-year-old sister, ██████████, had been sexually assaulted by Epstein and Maxwell in separate locations in 1996. ██████████ affidavit was filed in support of a defamation suit by Virginia ██████████ against Alan Dershowitz.^[69] According to the affidavit, ██████████ had met Maxwell and Epstein at a New York art gallery reception in 1995. The affidavit says that in the summer of the following year, they hired her to work on an art project in billionaire businessman Leslie Wexner's Ohio mansion, where she was then sexually assaulted by both Maxwell and Epstein.^{[70][71]} ██████████ reported the incident to the New York Police Department and the FBI.^{[52][72]} Her affidavit also stated that during the same summer, Epstein flew her then 15-year-old sister, ██████████, to his New Mexico property where he and Maxwell molested her on a massage table.^{[73][74]}

██████████ was interviewed for *CBS This Morning* in November 2019 where she detailed the 1996 assault and alleged that Maxwell had threatened both her career and her life after the assault.^[75]




Bill Clinton

William Jefferson Clinton (né **Blythe III**; born August 19, 1946) is an American politician who served as the 42nd president of the United States from 1993 to 2001. He previously served as governor of Arkansas from 1979 to 1981 and again from 1983 to 1992, and as attorney general of Arkansas from 1977 to 1979. A member of the Democratic Party, Clinton became known as a New Democrat, as many of his policies reflected a centrist "Third Way" political philosophy. He is the husband of Hillary Clinton, who was a senator from New York from 2001 to 2009, secretary of state from 2009 to 2013 and the Democratic nominee for president in the 2016 presidential election.

Clinton was born and raised in Arkansas and attended Georgetown University. He received a Rhodes Scholarship to study at University College, Oxford, and he later graduated from Yale Law School. He met Hillary Rodham at Yale; they married in 1975. After graduating from law school, Clinton returned to Arkansas and won election as state attorney general, followed by two non-consecutive terms as Arkansas governor. As governor, he overhauled the state's education system and served as chairman of the National Governors Association. Clinton was elected president in the 1992 presidential election, defeating incumbent Republican president George H. W. Bush and independent businessman Ross Perot. At 46 years old, he became the third-youngest president of the United States and the first president to be born in the Baby Boomer generation.

Clinton presided over the longest period of peacetime economic expansion in American history. He signed into law the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) and the Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act, but failed to pass his plan for national health care reform. The Republican Party won unified control of Congress for the first time in 40 years in the 1994 elections, but Clinton was still comfortably re-elected in 1996, becoming the first Democrat since Franklin D. Roosevelt to win a second full term. Starting in the mid-1990s, he began an ideological evolution as he became much more conservative in his domestic policy, advocating for and signing the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Act, the State Children's Health Insurance Program and financial deregulation measures. He appointed Ruth Bader Ginsburg and Stephen Breyer to the U.S. Supreme Court. During the last three years of

Gates is an avid reader, and the ceiling of his large home library is engraved with a quotation from *The Great Gatsby*.^[187] He also enjoys bridge, tennis and golf.^{[188][189]} His days are planned for him on a minute-by-minute basis, similarly to the U.S. president's schedule.^[190] Despite his wealth and extensive business travel, Gates flew coach (economy class) in commercial aircraft until 1997, when he bought a private jet.^[191]

Gates purchased the Codex Leicester, a collection of scientific writings by Leonardo da Vinci, for US\$30.8 million at an auction in 1994.^[192] In 1998, he reportedly paid \$30 million for the original 1885 maritime painting Lost on the Grand Banks, at the time a record price for an American painting.^[193]

In 2016, he revealed that he was color-blind.^[194]

Marriage and divorce

Gates married Melinda French on the Hawaiian Island of Lanai on January 1, 1994.^[195] They met in 1987 after Melinda began working at Microsoft.^[196] At the time of their marriage, Gates was given permission by Melinda to spend limited time with his ex-girlfriend, businesswoman Ann Winblad.^[197] Bill and Melinda have three children: Jennifer, Rory and Phoebe.^[198]

The family's residence is an earth-sheltered mansion in the side of a hill overlooking Lake Washington in Medina, Washington. In 2009, property taxes on the mansion were reported to be US\$1.063 million, on a total assessed value of US\$147.5 million.^[199]

The 66,000-square-foot (6,100 m²) estate has a 60-foot (18 m) swimming pool with an underwater music system, as well as a 2,500-square-foot (230 m²) gym and a 1,000-square-foot (93 m²) dining room.^[200] On May 3, 2021, the Gateses announced they had decided to divorce after 27 years of marriage and 34 years as a couple.^[201] They said they would keep working together on charitable efforts.^{[201][202]} *The Wall Street Journal* reported that Melinda had been meeting with divorce attorneys since 2019, citing interviews that suggested Bill's ties with Jeffrey Epstein was at least one of her concerns.^[203] The divorce was finalized on August 2, 2021.^[204]

A *New York Times* article reported that Gates's relationship with convicted sex offender Jeffrey Epstein started in 2011, just a few years after Epstein's conviction, and continued for some years, including a visit to Epstein's house with Melinda in the fall of 2013, despite her declared

Donald Trump

Donald John Trump (born June 14, 1946) is an American politician, media personality, and businessman who served as the 45th president of the United States from 2017 to 2021.

Trump graduated from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania with a bachelor's degree in 1968. He became president of his father Fred Trump's real estate business in 1971, and renamed it The Trump Organization. Trump expanded the company's operations to building and renovating skyscrapers, hotels, casinos, and golf courses. He later started side ventures, mostly by licensing his name. From 2004 to 2015, he co-produced and hosted the reality television series *The Apprentice*. Trump and his businesses have been involved in more than 4,000 state and federal legal actions, including six bankruptcies.

Trump's political positions have been described as populist, protectionist, isolationist, and nationalist. He won the 2016 United States presidential election as the Republican nominee against Democratic nominee Hillary Clinton while losing the popular vote,^[a] becoming the first U.S. president with no prior military or government service. His election and policies sparked numerous protests. The 2017–2019 special counsel investigation led by Robert Mueller established that Russia interfered in the 2016 election to benefit the Trump campaign, but not that members of the Trump campaign conspired or coordinated with Russia. Trump made many false and misleading statements during his campaigns and presidency, to a degree unprecedented in American politics, and promoted conspiracy theories. Many of his comments and actions have been characterized as racially charged or racist, and many as misogynistic.

Trump ordered a travel ban on citizens from several Muslim-majority countries, diverted military funding towards building a wall on the U.S.–Mexico border, and implemented a policy of family separations for apprehended migrants. He signed the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017, which cut taxes for individuals and businesses and rescinded the individual health insurance mandate penalty of the Affordable Care Act. He appointed 54 federal appellate judges and three United States Supreme Court justices. In foreign policy, Trump pursued an America First agenda, withdrawing

Epstein a massage". She claims she was taken to his mansion, where he exposed himself and had sexual intercourse with her, and paid her \$200 immediately afterward.^[106]

A similar \$50-million suit was filed in March 2008, by a different woman, who was represented by the same lawyer.^[129] These and several similar lawsuits were dismissed.^[130]

All other lawsuits have been settled by Epstein out of court.^[131] Epstein made many out-of-court settlements with alleged victims.^[130]

Victims' rights: *Jane Does v. United States* (2014)

A December 30, 2014, federal civil suit was filed in Florida by Jane Doe 1 (██████████) and Jane Doe 2 against the United States for violations of the Crime Victims' Rights Act by the U.S. Department of Justice's NPA with Epstein and his limited 2008 state plea. There was a later unsuccessful effort to add ██████████ (Jane Doe 3) and another woman (Jane Doe 4) as plaintiffs to that case.^[132] The addition accused Alan Dershowitz of sexually abusing a minor, Jane Doe 3, provided by Epstein.^[133] The allegations against Dershowitz were stricken by the judge and eliminated from the case because he said they were outside the intent of the suit to re-open the plea agreement.^{[134][135]} A document filed in court alleges that Epstein ran a "sexual abuse ring", and lent underage girls to "prominent American politicians, powerful business executives, foreign presidents, a well-known prime minister, and other world leaders".^[136]

This long-running lawsuit is pending in federal court, aimed at vacating the federal plea agreement on the grounds that it violated victims' rights.^[137] On April 7, 2015, Judge Kenneth Marra ruled that the allegations made by alleged victim ██████████ against Prince Andrew had no bearing on the lawsuit by alleged victims seeking to reopen Epstein's non-prosecution plea agreement with the federal government; the judge ordered that allegation to be struck from the record.^[134] Judge Marra made no ruling as to whether claims by ██████████ are true or false. Though he did not allow Jane Does 3 and 4 to join the suit, Marra specifically said that ██████████ may later give evidence when the case comes to court.^[138]

On February 21, 2019, in the case of *Two Jane Does v. United States*, Senior Judge of the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida Kenneth Marra said federal prosecutors violated the law by failing to notify victims before they allowed him to plead guilty to only the two Florida offenses. The judge left open what the possible remedy could be.^[139]


██████████ v. Epstein (2015)

In a December 2014 Florida court filing by Bradley Edwards and Paul G. Cassell meant for inclusion in the Crime Victims Rights Act lawsuit,^[140] ██████████ (then known as ██████████), alleged in a sworn affidavit that at age 17, she had been sexually trafficked by Epstein and Ghislaine Maxwell for their own use and for use by several others, including Prince Andrew^[141] and retired Harvard Law professor Alan Dershowitz.^{[8][142]} ██████████ also claimed that Epstein, Maxwell and others had physically and sexually abused her.^[143] She alleged that the FBI may have been involved in a cover-up.^[144] She said she had served as Epstein's sex slave from 1999 to 2002, and had recruited other underage girls.^[145] Prince Andrew, Epstein, and Dershowitz all denied having had sex with ██████████. Dershowitz took legal action over the allegations.^{[146][147][148]} ██████████ filed a defamation suit against Dershowitz,

In March 2005, a woman contacted Florida's Palm Beach Police Department and alleged that her 14-year-old stepdaughter had been taken to Epstein's mansion by an older girl. While there, she was allegedly paid \$300 (equivalent to \$420 in 2021) to strip and massage Epstein.^[92] She had allegedly undressed, but left the encounter wearing her underwear.^[93]

Palm Beach Police began a 13-month undercover investigation of Epstein, including a search of his home.^{[71][94]} During the investigation, Palm Beach Police Chief Michael Reiter publicly accused the Palm Beach County state prosecutor, Barry Krischer, of being too lenient and called for help from the FBI.^[92]

The Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) then became involved. Subsequently, the police alleged that Epstein had paid several girls to perform sexual acts with him.^[89] Interviews with five alleged victims and 17 witnesses under oath, a high-school transcript and other items found in Epstein's trash and home allegedly showed that some of the girls involved were under 18, the youngest being 14, with many under 16.^{[95][96]} The police search of Epstein's home found two hidden cameras and large numbers of photos of girls throughout the house, some of whom the police had interviewed in the course of their investigation.^[93] [REDACTED], a former model from Poland who became an Epstein assistant, reportedly removed computer drives and other electronic equipment from the financier's Florida mansion before Palm Beach Police searched the home as part of their investigation.^[97] The court documents record that a search of Epstein's residence by Palm Beach Police detective Joseph Recarey in 2005 uncovered an incriminating Amazon receipt containing books on S&M. The books he ordered are titled: *SM 101: A Realistic Introduction*, *SlaveCraft: Roadmaps for Erotic Servitude - Principles, Skills and Tools* and *Training with Miss Abernathy: A Workbook for Erotic Slaves and Their Owners.*^[98]

A former employee told the police that Epstein would receive massages three times a day.^[93] Eventually the FBI compiled reports on "34 confirmed minors" eligible for restitution (increased to 40 in the NPA) whose allegations of sexual abuse by Epstein included corroborating details.^[99] Julie Brown's 2018 exposés in the Miami Herald identified about 80 victims and located about 60 of them.^{[1][71][100]} She quotes the then police chief Reiter as saying "This was 50-something 'shes' and one 'he'—and the 'shes' all basically told the same story."^[1] Details from the investigation included allegations that 12-year-old triplets were flown in from France for Epstein's birthday, and flown back the following day after being sexually abused by the financier. It was alleged that young girls were recruited from Brazil and other South American countries, former Soviet countries, and Europe, and that Jean-Luc Brunel's "MC2" modeling agency was also supplying girls to Epstein.^{[95][101][102]}

MODELLING.

In May 2006, Palm Beach police filed a probable cause affidavit saying that Epstein should be charged with four counts of unlawful sex with minors and one count of sexual abuse.^{[93][103]} On July 27, 2006, Epstein was arrested by the Palm Beach Police Department on state felony charges of procuring a minor for prostitution and solicitation of a prostitute. He was booked at the Palm Beach County jail and later released on a \$3,000 bond.^{[5][9][104][105]} State prosecutor Krischer later convened a Palm Beach County grand jury, which was usually only done in capital cases. Presented evidence from only two victims, the grand jury returned a single charge of felony solicitation of prostitution,^[106] to which Epstein pleaded not guilty in August 2006.^[107]

Epstein's defense lawyers included Roy Black, Gerald Lefcourt, Harvard Law School professor Alan Dershowitz, and former U.S. Solicitor General Ken Starr.^{[92][108]} Linguist Steven Pinker also assisted.^[109]

While in college, Trump obtained four student draft deferments during the Vietnam War era.^[11] In 1966, he was deemed fit for military service based upon a medical examination, and in July 1968 a local draft board classified him as eligible to serve.^[12] In October 1968, he was classified 1-Y, a conditional medical deferment,^[13] and in 1972, he was reclassified 4-F due to bone spurs, permanently disqualifying him from service.^[14]

In 1977, Trump married Czech model Ivana Zelníčková.^[15] They have three children, Donald Jr. (born 1977), Ivanka (born 1981), and Eric (born 1984). Ivana became a naturalized United States citizen in 1988.^[16] The couple divorced in 1992, following Trump's affair with actress Marla Maples.^[17] He and Maples have one daughter, Tiffany (born 1993).^[18] They married in 1993, separated in 1997, and divorced in 1999.^[19] Tiffany was raised by Marla in California.^[20] In 2005, Trump married Slovenian model Melania Knauss.^[21] They have one son, Barron (born 2006).^[22] Melania gained U.S. citizenship in 2006.^[23]

Religion

Trump went to Sunday school and was confirmed in 1959 at the First Presbyterian Church in Jamaica, Queens.^{[24][25]} In the 1970s, his parents joined the Marble Collegiate Church in Manhattan, which belongs to the Reformed Church.^{[24][26]} The pastor at Marble, Norman Vincent Peale,^[24] ministered to the family until his death in 1993.^[26] Trump has described him as a mentor.^[27] In 2015, the church stated that Trump was not an active member.^[25] In 2019, he appointed his personal pastor, televangelist Paula White, to the White House Office of Public Liaison.^[28] In 2020, he said he identified as a non-denominational Christian.^[29]

Wealth

In 1982, Trump made the initial Forbes list of wealthy people for holding a share of his family's estimated \$200 million net worth. His losses in the 1980s dropped him from the list between 1990 and 1995.^[30] After filing mandatory financial disclosure forms with the FEC in July 2015, he announced a net worth of about \$10 billion. Records released by the FEC showed at least \$1.4 billion in assets and \$265 million in liabilities.^[31] Forbes estimated his net worth at \$4.5 billion in 2015 and \$3.1 billion in 2018.^[32] In its 2021 billionaires ranking, it was \$2.4 billion (1,299th in the world), making him one of the wealthiest officeholders in American history.^[33]

Journalist Jonathan Greenberg reported in 2018 that Trump, using the pseudonym "John Barron" and claiming to be a Trump Organization official, called him in 1984 to falsely assert that he owned "in excess of ninety percent" of the Trump family's business, to secure a higher ranking on the Forbes 400 list of wealthy Americans. Greenberg also wrote that Forbes had vastly overestimated Trump's wealth and wrongly included him on the Forbes 400 rankings of 1982, 1983, and 1984.^[34]

Trump has often said he began his career with "a small loan of one million dollars" from his father, and that he had to pay it back with interest.^[35] He was a millionaire by age eight, borrowed at least \$60 million from his father, largely failed to repay those loans, and received another \$413 million (adjusted for inflation) from his father's company.^{[36][37]} In 2018, he and his family were reported to have committed tax fraud, and the New York tax department began investigating.^[38] His investments underperformed the stock and New York property markets.^{[39][40]} Forbes estimated in October 2018 that his net worth declined from \$4.5 billion in 2015 to \$3.1 billion in 2017 and his product licensing income from \$23 million to \$3 million.^[41]

Targeted victim was approached by a woman in a clothing store located in the Kadina district while shopping with her mother, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and asked if she would be interested in doing modelling as a Kmart catalogue model in Kmart catalogues.

The targeted victim replied "I will have to ask my mother", and proceeded to walk towards her mother while the unknown woman waited for her to return.

The targeted victim approached her mother and informed her mother of what the woman had proposed regarding becoming a model for Kmart catalogues.

The targeted victims mother informed her daughter, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (targeted victim) that she could not allow her daughter to do modelling due to financial reasons and that she was raising a family of four children and could not support her daughter by accompanying her to modelling shoots, which would be necessary as she was a minor of 14 years of age.

The targeted victim returned to the woman who stood waiting for her and informed her that she would have to decline the offer of doing modelling.

The woman smiled at the targeted victim before leaving the clothing store.

The woman was unknown to the targeted victim and was not sighted in the Kadina district again following this incident by the targeted victim.

Bloom asserted that the woman had received threats. The suit was dropped on November 4, 2016. Trump attorney Alan Garten denied the allegations, while Epstein declined to comment.^{[156][157][158][159][160]}

██████████ v. Epstein and Maxwell (2017)

In 2017, ██████████ filed a suit against Epstein and Maxwell, alleging that Maxwell had hired her to give massages to Epstein and later threatened to physically harm her or destroy her career prospects if she did not comply with their sexual demands at his mansion in New York City and on his private Caribbean island, Little Saint James. The suit was settled in 2018 under undisclosed terms.^{[161][20][162]}



Epstein was accused of sex trafficking of minors at his mansion at 9 East 71st Street.

Bradley Edwards' defamation v. Epstein (2018)

A state civil lawsuit in Florida filed by attorney Bradley Edwards against Epstein was scheduled for trial in December 2018. The trial was expected to provide victims with their first opportunity to make their accusations in public. However, the case was settled on the first day of the trial, with Epstein publicly apologizing to Edwards; other terms of the settlement were confidential.^{[137][163]}

██████████ v. Epstein and Maxwell (2019)

On April 16, 2019, ██████████ went public and filed a sworn affidavit in federal court in New York, alleging that she and her 15-year-old sister ██████████, had been sexually assaulted by Epstein and Maxwell in separate locations in 1996. ██████████ met Epstein and Maxwell at her graduate art gallery reception at the New York Academy of Art in 1995. The following year, in the summer of 1996, they hired her to work on an art project in Leslie Wexner's Ohio mansion, where she was then sexually assaulted.^[164] ██████████ reported the incident to the New York City Police Department and the FBI.^[165]

██████████ affidavit also stated that during the same summer, Epstein flew her then-15-year-old sister to his New Mexico property where he and Maxwell sexually abused her on a massage table.^[166]

██████████ v. Epstein and Maxwell (2019)

On July 22, 2019, while in jail awaiting trial, Epstein was served with a petition regarding a pending state civil lawsuit filed by ██████████.^[167] She stated that an associate for Epstein had recruited her outside Talent Unlimited High School at age 14 and she was gradually groomed for over a year before Epstein raped her in his New York City mansion when she was 15.^[168] ██████████ filed her suit on August 14, 2019, when New York State law was updated to allow one year for adult survivors of child sexual abuse to sue for previous offenses, regardless of how long ago the abuse took place.^[169] In October 2019, ██████████ amended her complaint to include over 20 corporate entities associated with Epstein and named the additional individuals Lesley Groff and ██████████ as enablers.^[170]
