

Epstein a massage". She claims she was taken to his mansion, where he exposed himself and had sexual intercourse with her, and paid her \$200 immediately afterward.^[106]

A similar \$50-million suit was filed in March 2008, by a different woman, who was represented by the same lawyer.^[129] These and several similar lawsuits were dismissed.^[130]

All other lawsuits have been settled by Epstein out of court.^[131] Epstein made many out-of-court settlements with alleged victims.^[130]

Victims' rights: *Jane Does v. United States (2014)*

SEXUAL ABUSE RING
PROMINENT POSITIONS

A December 30, 2014, federal civil suit was filed in Florida by Jane Doe 1 (Courtney Wild) and Jane Doe 2 against the United States for violations of the Crime Victims' Rights Act by the U.S. Department of Justice's NPA with Epstein and his limited 2008 state plea. There was a later unsuccessful effort to add Virginia Roberts (Jane Doe 3) and another woman (Jane Doe 4) as plaintiffs to that case.^[132] The addition accused Alan Dershowitz of sexually abusing a minor, Jane Doe 3, provided by Epstein.^[133] The allegations against Dershowitz were stricken by the judge and eliminated from the case because he said they were outside the intent of the suit to re-open the plea agreement.^{[134][135]} A document filed in court alleges that Epstein ran a "sexual abuse ring", and lent underage girls to "prominent American politicians, powerful business executives, foreign presidents, a well-known prime minister, and other world leaders".^[136]

This long-running lawsuit is pending in federal court, aimed at vacating the federal plea agreement on the grounds that it violated victims' rights.^[137] On April 7, 2015, Judge Kenneth Marra ruled that the allegations made by alleged victim Virginia Roberts against Prince Andrew had no bearing on the lawsuit by alleged victims seeking to reopen Epstein's non-prosecution plea agreement with the federal government; the judge ordered that allegation to be struck from the record.^[134] Judge Marra made no ruling as to whether claims by Roberts are true or false. Though he did not allow Jane Does 3 and 4 to join the suit, Marra specifically said that Roberts may later give evidence when the case comes to court.^[138]

On February 21, 2019, in the case of Two Jane Does v. United States, Senior Judge of the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida Kenneth Marra said federal prosecutors violated the law by failing to notify victims before they allowed him to plead guilty to only the two Florida offenses. The judge left open what the possible remedy could be.^[139]

Virginia Giuffre v. Epstein (2015)

In a December 2014 Florida court filing by Bradley Edwards and Paul G. Cassell meant for inclusion in the Crime Victims Rights Act lawsuit,^[140] Virginia Giuffre (then known as Virginia Roberts), alleged in a sworn affidavit that at age 17, she had been sexually trafficked by Epstein and Ghislaine Maxwell for their own use and for use by several others, including Prince Andrew^[141] and retired Harvard Law professor Alan Dershowitz.^{[8][142]} Giuffre also claimed that Epstein, Maxwell and others had physically and sexually abused her.^[143] She alleged that the FBI may have been involved in a cover-up.^[144] She said she had served as Epstein's sex slave from 1999 to 2002, and had recruited other underage girls.^[145] Prince Andrew, Epstein, and Dershowitz all denied having had sex with Giuffre. Dershowitz took legal action over the allegations.^{[146][147][148]} Giuffre filed a defamation suit against Dershowitz,


Bloom asserted that the woman had received threats. The suit was dropped on November 4, 2016. Trump attorney Alan Garten denied the allegations, while Epstein declined to comment.^{[156][157][158][159][160]}

***DESTRUCTION OF CAREER - INTELL PROP THEFT - SEXUAL ABUSE RING - DEMAND**
Sarah Ransome v. Epstein and Maxwell (2017)

In 2017, Sarah Ransome filed a suit against Epstein and Maxwell, alleging that Maxwell had hired her to give massages to Epstein and later threatened to physically harm her or destroy her career prospects if she did not comply with their sexual demands at his mansion in New York City and on his private Caribbean island, Little Saint James. The suit was settled in 2018 under undisclosed terms.^{[161][20][162]}

Bradley Edwards' defamation v. Epstein (2018)

A state civil lawsuit in Florida filed by attorney Bradley Edwards against Epstein was scheduled for trial in December 2018. The trial was expected to provide victims with their first opportunity to make their accusations in public. However, the case was settled on the first day of the trial, with Epstein publicly apologizing to Edwards; other terms of the settlement were confidential.^{[137][163]}

Maria Farmer v. Epstein and Maxwell (2019)

 On April 16, 2019, Maria Farmer went public and filed a sworn affidavit in federal court in New York, alleging that she and her 15-year-old sister, Annie, had been sexually assaulted by Epstein and Maxwell in separate locations in 1996. Farmer met Epstein and Maxwell at her graduate art gallery reception at the New York Academy of Art in 1995. The following year, in the summer of 1996, they hired her to work on an art project in Leslie Wexner's Ohio mansion, where she was then sexually assaulted.^[164] Farmer reported the incident to the New York City Police Department and the FBI.^[165]

Farmer's affidavit also stated that during the same summer, Epstein flew her then-15-year-old sister to his New Mexico property where he and Maxwell sexually abused her on a massage table.^[166]

Jennifer Araoz v. Epstein and Maxwell (2019)

On July 22, 2019, while in jail awaiting trial, Epstein was served with a petition regarding a pending state civil lawsuit filed by Jennifer Araoz.^[167] She stated that an associate for Epstein had recruited her outside Talent Unlimited High School at age 14 and she was gradually groomed for over a year before Epstein raped her in his New York City mansion when she was 15.^[168] Araoz filed her suit on August 14, 2019, when New York State law was updated to allow one year for adult survivors of child sexual abuse to sue for previous offenses, regardless of how long ago the abuse took place.^[169] In October 2019, Araoz amended her complaint to include over 20 corporate entities associated with Epstein and named the additional individuals Lesley Groff and Cimberly Espinosa as enablers.^[170]

Epstein attended local public schools, first attending Public School 188, and then Mark Twain Junior High School nearby.^[26] In 1967, Epstein attended the National Music Camp at the Interlochen Center for the Arts.^[29] He began playing the piano when he was five.^[30] He graduated in 1969 from Lafayette High School at age 16, having skipped two grades.^{[31][32]} Later that year, he attended classes at Cooper Union until he changed colleges in 1971.^[31] From September 1971, he attended the Courant Institute of Mathematical Sciences at New York University, but left without receiving a degree in June 1974.^{[31][32]}

Career

Teaching

Epstein started working in September 1974 as a physics and mathematics teacher for teens at the Dalton School on the Upper East Side of Manhattan.^{[31][33]} Donald Barr, who served as the headmaster until June 1974,^{[34][35][36]} was known to have made several unconventional recruitments at the time, although it is unclear whether he had a direct role in hiring Epstein.^{[33][37][38]} Three months after Barr's departure, Epstein began to teach at the school, despite his lack of credentials.^[38] Epstein allegedly showed inappropriate behavior toward underage students at the time.^{[33][37]} He became acquainted with Alan Greenberg, the chief executive officer of Bear Stearns, whose son and daughter were attending the school. Greenberg's daughter, Lynne Koepfel, pointed to a parent-teacher conference where Epstein influenced another Dalton parent into advocating for him to Greenberg.^[35] In June 1976, after Epstein was dismissed from Dalton for "poor performance",^{[33][39][40]} Greenberg offered him a job at Bear Stearns.^{[30][41]}

Banking

Epstein joined Bear Stearns in 1976 as a low-level junior assistant to a floor trader.^[42] He swiftly moved up to become an options trader, working in the special products division, and then advised the bank's wealthiest clients, such as Seagram president Edgar Bronfman, on tax mitigation strategies.^{[32][43][44]} Jimmy Cayne, the bank's later chief executive officer, praised Epstein's skill with wealthy clients and complex products. In 1980, four years after joining Bear Stearns, Epstein became a limited partner.^[42]

In 1981, he was asked to leave Bear Stearns for, according to his sworn testimony, being guilty of a "Reg D violation".^{[45][32][30]} Even though Epstein departed abruptly, he remained close to Cayne and Greenberg and was a client of Bear Stearns until its collapse in 2008.^[42]

Financial consulting

In August 1981, Epstein founded his own consulting firm, Intercontinental Assets Group Inc. (IAG),^[46] which assisted clients in recovering stolen money from fraudulent brokers and lawyers.^[30] Epstein described his work at this time as being a high-level bounty hunter. He told friends that he worked sometimes as a consultant for governments and the very wealthy to recover embezzled funds, while at other times he worked for clients who had embezzled funds.^{[30][47]} Spanish actress and heiress Ana Obregón was one such wealthy client, whom Epstein helped in 1982 to recover her father's millions in lost investments, which had disappeared when Drysdale Government Securities collapsed because of fraud.^[48]

Liquid Funding was initially 40 percent owned by Bear Stearns. Through the help of the credit rating agencies – Standard & Poor's, Fitch Ratings and Moody's Investors Service – the new bundled securities were able to be created for companies so that they got a gold-plated AAA rating. The implosion of such complex securities, because of their inaccurate ratings, led to the collapse of Bear Stearns in March 2008 and set in motion the financial crisis of 2007–2008 and the subsequent Great Recession. If Liquid Funding were left holding large amounts of such securities as collateral, it could have lost large amounts of money.^{[65][67]}


Investments

Hedge funds

Between 2002 and 2005, Epstein invested \$80 million in the D.B. Zwirn Special Opportunities Fund, a hedge fund that invested in illiquid debt securities.^{[68][69]} In November 2006, Epstein attempted to redeem his investment after he was informed of accounting irregularities in the fund.^[70] By this time, his investment had grown to \$140 million. The D.B. Zwirn fund refused to redeem the investment. Hedge funds that invest in illiquid securities typically have years-long "lockups" on their capital for all investors and require redemption requests to be made in writing 60 to 90 days in advance.^[68] The fund was closed in 2008, and its remaining assets of approximately \$2 billion, including Epstein's investment, were transferred to Fortress Investment Group when that firm bought the assets in 2009.^{[68][69]} Epstein later went to arbitration with Fortress over his redemption attempt. The outcome of that arbitration is not publicly known.^[68]

 In August 2006, Epstein, a month after the federal investigation of him began,^[71] invested \$57 million in the Bear Stearns High-Grade Structured Credit Strategies Enhanced Leverage hedge fund.^{[68][72]} This fund was highly leveraged in mortgage-backed collateralized debt obligations (CDOs).^[72]

On April 18, 2007, an investor in the fund, who had \$57 million invested, discussed redeeming his investment.^[73] At this time, the fund had a leverage ratio of 17:1, which meant for every dollar invested there were seventeen dollars of borrowed funds; therefore, the redemption of this investment would have been equivalent to removing \$1 billion from the thinly traded CDO market.^[74] The selling of CDO assets to meet the redemptions that month began a repricing process and general freeze in the CDO market. The repricing of the CDO assets caused the collapse of the fund three months later in July, and the eventual collapse of Bear Stearns in March 2008. It is likely Epstein lost most of this investment, but it is not known how much was his.^{[73][72]}



The government began negotiation with Epstein for a plea agreement in mid-2007, as the hedge fund began to collapse.

By the time that the Bear Stearns fund began to fail in May 2007, Epstein had begun to negotiate a plea deal with the U.S. Attorney's Office concerning imminent charges for sex with minors.^{[68][71]} In August 2007, a month after the fund collapsed, the U.S. attorney in Miami, Alexander Acosta, entered into direct discussions about the plea agreement.^[71] Acosta brokered a lenient deal, according to him, because he had been ordered by higher government officials, who told him that Epstein was an individual of importance to the government.^{[52][53]} As part of the negotiations, according to the Miami Herald, Epstein provided "unspecified information" to the Florida federal prosecutors for a more lenient sentence and was supposedly an unnamed key witness for the New York federal prosecutors in their unsuccessful June 2008 criminal case against the two managers

Non-prosecution agreement (NPA) (2006–2008)

In July 2006, the FBI began its own investigation of Epstein, nicknamed "Operation Leap Year".^[110] It resulted in a 53-page indictment in June 2007.^[71] Alexander Acosta, then the U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of Florida, agreed to a plea deal, which Alan Dershowitz helped to negotiate,^[111] to grant immunity from all federal criminal charges to Epstein, along with four named co-conspirators and any unnamed "potential co-conspirators".^{*} According to the *Miami Herald*, the non-prosecution agreement "essentially shut down an ongoing FBI probe into whether there were more victims and other powerful people who took part in Epstein's sex crimes". At the time, this halted the investigation and sealed the indictment. The *Miami Herald* said: "Acosta agreed, despite a federal law to the contrary, that the deal would be kept from the victims."^[1]

The controversial non-prosecution agreement

Acosta later said he offered a lenient plea deal because he was told that Epstein "belonged to intelligence", was "above his pay grade" and to "leave it alone".^{[52][53][112]} Epstein agreed to plead guilty in Florida state court to two felony prostitution charges, serve 18 months in prison, register as a sex offender, and pay restitution to three dozen victims identified by the FBI.^{[1][89]} The plea deal was later described as a "sweetheart deal".^[113]

A federal judge later found that the prosecutors had violated the victims' rights in that they had concealed the agreement from the victims and instead urged them to have "patience".^{[114][115]}

According to an internal review conducted by the Department of Justice's Office of Professional Responsibility, which was released in November 2020, Acosta showed "poor judgment" in granting Epstein a non-prosecution agreement and failing to notify Epstein's alleged victims about this agreement.^[116]

Conviction and sentencing (2008–2011)

On June 30, 2008, after Epstein pleaded guilty to a state charge (one of two) of procuring for prostitution a girl below age 18,^[117] he was sentenced to 18 months in prison. While most convicted sex offenders in Florida are sent to state prison, Epstein was instead housed in a private wing of the Palm Beach County Stockade and, according to the sheriff's office, was after 3½ months allowed to leave the jail on "work release" for up to 12 hours a day, 6 days a week. This contravened the sheriff's own policies requiring a maximum remaining sentence of 10 months and making sex offenders ineligible for the privilege. He was allowed to come and go outside of specified release hours.^[100]

Epstein's cell door was left unlocked, and he had access to the attorney room where a television was installed for him, before he was moved to the Stockade's previously unstaffed infirmary. He worked at the office of a foundation he had created shortly before reporting to jail; he dissolved it after he had served his time. The Sheriff's Office received \$128,000 from Epstein's non-profit to pay for the costs of extra services being provided during his work release. His office was monitored by "permit deputies" whose overtime was paid by Epstein. They were required to wear suits, and checked in "welcomed guests" at the "front desk". Later the Sheriff's Office said these guest logs were destroyed per the department's "records retention" rules (although inexplicably the Stockade ^[118] He was allowed to use his own driver to drive him between jail and his

Royal Commission investigation into the scheme, Rudd accepted his Government's responsibility for systems failures that led to the deaths, describing them as a "deep tragedy" and acknowledged the pain of the families involved. The Building the Education Revolution program rolled out 23,670 school projects around Australia representing a completion rate of 92 per cent. [124] However, claims of overpricing and poor value for money in some projects resulted in a taskforce being established to examine the implementation of the scheme, led by Brad Orgill, the former CEO of UBS Australasia. Only 3% of complaints about the scheme were upheld, and most projects were found to have been good value for money. [125]

In early 2009, [126] in the wake of the global financial crisis, [127] Rudd stated "that the great neo-liberal experiment of the past 30 years has failed", and that "Neo-liberalism and the free-market fundamentalism it has produced has been revealed as little more than personal greed dressed up as an economic philosophy. And, ironically, it now falls to social democracy to prevent liberal capitalism from cannibalising itself." Rudd called for a new era of "social capitalism" from social democrats such as himself and US President Barack Obama to "support a global financial system that properly balances private incentive with public responsibility". [128] The Center for Strategic and International Studies has acknowledged Kevin Rudd as one of the founders of the G20 that helped prevent a second global depression. [129]

The Rudd Government's third budget in 2010 projected a \$40.8 billion deficit for 2010-11 [130] but forecast that Australia would return to surplus by 2012-13. The government proposed a "super profits" tax on the mining industry and included \$12 billion in revenue from the proposal in the forecast, although the tax had not been passed by the Senate. [131]

Australia 2020 Summit

In February 2008 Rudd announced the Australia 2020 Summit, held from 19-20 April 2008, which brought together 1000 leading Australians to discuss ten major areas of policy innovation. [132] Among the initiatives supported at the event, the summit voted in favour of a plebiscite on Australia "relinquishing ties" to the United Kingdom followed by a referendum on the model for an Australian republic, [133] a bill of rights, the re-formation of an Indigenous peak representative body similar to ATSIC, (which had been abolished by the Howard Government), the introduction of an Emissions Trading Scheme and a National Disability Insurance Scheme, and a review of the taxation system. [134]

Findings released in April 2009 reported that nine out of the 1000 submitted ideas were to be immediately enacted and that the government was deliberating on other ideas proposed. [135] By mid-2010, among the key reform ideas suggested, Prime Minister Rudd had sought to introduce an ETS, but postponed it after failing to secure passage through the senate; [136] formed a consultative committee on a Bill of rights then rejected its recommendation for implementation; [137] established the National Congress of Australia's First Peoples in 2010; [138] commissioned the Henry Review of taxation (on the basis of which the Rudd Government proposed a new "super-profits" tax on mining); [139] and Rudd had described the issue of a vote on a republic as not being "a priority". [140]

Industrial relations

Rann was comfortably re-elected in 2006, taking 28 seats to the Liberals' 15—to date, Labor's largest majority since the abolition of the Playmander. Labor also garnered a two-party vote of 56.8 percent, a significant comeback from its low of 39 percent in 1993 under Arnold.

Rann personally likened his government to Dunstan's, stating "I'm a totally different person to Don Dunstan, but in the 70s for different reasons South Australia stood head and shoulders above the crowd. We stood out, we were leaders. The federal government is setting up a social inclusion unit based on ours. Again it's about us not only making a difference locally, but being a kind of model for others, which is what Dunstan used to say he wanted us to be ... a laboratory and a leader for the future." Rann says he expected other reforms to be based upon those enacted under his government, citing the state's strategic plan, a 10-year framework for the development of government and business. "It's a plan for the state, not just promises at each election. A lot of colleagues interstate thought I'd gone mad when we named targets. Well we didn't want to set targets we could easily pass and then pat ourselves on the back for, what's the point of that?"^[16] A total of 79 economic and social targets were set,^[17] and in 2010 Rann commented "with most of its targets achieved, on track or within reach".^[18] However, the state's Integrated Design Commissioner, Tim Horton, said in 2011: "Its targets are really great, but I don't think any of us have signed on to why those targets exist or what we can do to further them. It's a top-down approach. I worry the document exists in the minds of agencies but not in the minds of people."^[19]

During Rann's first and second terms, Rann was often the most popular Premier in the country, with his approach to government generally moderate and crisis-free.^[20] Newspoll early in 2007 saw Rann peak at a historic 64 per cent as Preferred Premier, and 61 per cent on the two-party-preferred vote. University of Adelaide Professor of Politics Clem Macintyre said that after the State Bank collapse, Rann had to re-establish Labor's credentials as an economic manager as a matter of urgency, and "in that sense Rann had a whole lot of priorities to concentrate on that Dunstan didn't even think about", with a legacy built on economic achievements, achieving the triple-A credit rating, as well as its capacity to deliver infrastructure projects.^[21]

Fourth quarter 2007 polling saw a reduction in the strong support for Rann's Labor government since the previous election, on 54 percent of the two-party-preferred vote, a fall from the previous poll of five percent. Rann's Preferred Premier rating was at 50 percent compared to 25 percent for then Liberal leader Martin Hamilton-Smith.^{[22][23]} Third quarter 2008 polling saw a more pronounced drop in the primary vote, down three to 38 percent, with the Liberal vote up five to 40 percent, breaking to a two-party vote of 50–50 after preferences – the Preferred Premier figure recorded a six-point drop to 48 percent for Rann and up three to 30 percent for Hamilton-Smith. Some commentators put the poll slump down to "labour movement ructions" over the underfunded WorkCover liability (see 2008 Parnell–Bressington filibuster), consolidation of rural health services, and the continued degradation of the River Murray.^{[24][25]}

Newspoll saw Labor back in a winning position on 54 to 46 in late 2008, and then 56 to 44 in early 2009 along with increases in the Preferred Premier rating. Polling taken from The Sunday Mail during the 50-50 polling suggested that whilst there had been large swings away from the government in country areas, polling held relatively firm at 2006 election levels in the metropolitan areas.^[26]

The 2009 Frome by-election saw Labor pick up a small increase in the two-party-preferred vote. This, coupled with the "dodgy documents affair", also known as "dodgy-gate", saw Hamilton-Smith step down from the Liberal leadership, to be replaced by Isobel Redmond.

John David Hill (born 3 December 1949), Australian politician, represented the electoral district of Kurna in the South Australian House of Assembly for the Labor Party from 1997 to 2014.

Born in Sydney, Hill attended the University of Sydney and graduated with a Bachelor of Arts. He moved to South Australia in 1974 and became a teacher. He also studied at the University of Adelaide and received his law degree.

Following a brief stint as a ministerial adviser during the Bannon Government, Hill became a party official, becoming State Secretary in 1994. He was elected to Parliament as member for Kurna at the 1997 state election.

After Labor won the 2002 election, Hill became a minister in the Rann Government. Initially given the portfolios of Minister for Environment and Conservation, Minister for the River Murray, Minister for the Southern Suburbs, Minister Assisting the Premier in the Arts and Minister for Gambling, Hill gained his current portfolios after a number of cabinet reshuffles.

The 2006 election saw Hill gain a swing of 11.0% to a total margin of 22.0%.

Hill did not re-contest his seat at the 2014 election.^[1]

Hill is a member of the Ministers' Club at EPODE International Network – the world's largest obesity-prevention network.^{[2][3]}

John Hill's political memoir, *On Being a Minister - Behind the Mask*, was published in February 2016.^[4]

Country Health SA launches Inpatient Dashboards for Port Augusta and Mount Gambier

 Residents of Port Augusta and Mount Gambier will now be able to access up-to-date information about the amount of people being treated in their local public hospitals.


The Country Health SA Local Health Network (CHSALHN) launched inpatient dashboards for Port Augusta and Mount Gambier Hospitals following the successful release of the metropolitan data earlier this year.

Professor Belinda Moyes, Chief Executive Officer CHSA LHN said the inpatient dashboards provide country residents with an opportunity to learn more about how their hospitals are managed.

"The inpatient dashboard provides detailed information on the number of inpatients at each hospital at any one time," Professor Moyes said.

"South Australia was the first state in the country to make this level of information available to the public and we are excited to extend this technology to country residents."

"Through the dashboard the general public can gain a better understanding about how patient flow is managed in our busy hospital environments."



How to interpret this chart

This table shows a summary of the status of all inpatient beds in the Port Augusta Hospital (PAHS). In an online environment, you can click on the chosen hospital in the table and the whole dashboard will update to show data specific to that hospital. The dashboard displays occupancy per hospital split across 'general' beds and 'all' beds, breakdown of inpatients, the length of stay, and much more.

Professor Moyes said the dashboard, which is available online, will be updated every 30 minutes to provide real-time information about bed occupancy, average length of stay and inpatient flows.

"The dashboard also includes information specific to each hospital about the number of patients currently within each area or clinical unit at the hospital," Professor Moyes said.

"It allows people to easily see all of the different 'streams' of inpatient care that each hospital provides, such as surgical or pediatrics, and the status of each of these areas.

"Staff already use the dashboard, along with a range of other tools, to help monitor and manage capacity and ensure that patient safety is maintained.

"By releasing this data publicly we are continuing to make our health system more transparent."

* Thank you for your letter dated 19 January 2020, regarding an investigation into alleged intellectual property theft of two business plans you developed between 2007 and 2011. I note you have also written to Hon Vickie Chapman MP, Attorney-General, and Hon Steven Marshall MP, Premier.

* GP Plus Health Care Centres are a State Government initiative. The Port Pirie GP Plus Centre was one of the last of eight GP Plus Centres to be constructed in South Australia. These centres are the foundation of primary health care. They provide advice on how to manage chronic diseases, provision of support for more in-home care and guidance for those who want to stay healthy.

The Port Pirie GP Plus Centre does not have an after-hours GP service, however, the local GPs provide some after-hours services through their privately run medical practices.

* I note your concerns raised regarding intellectual property theft, however, SA Health is not in a position to investigate this further as private medical practices or specialist clinics are not under the governance of SA Health.

I can see you have previously been provided with contact information for the Legal Services Commission of South Australia (LSC). Should you wish to pursue this matter further you can reach the LSC Legal Helpline on 1300 366 424.

* I note from your letter that this has created hardship emotionally, mentally, physically and financially. Please contact your GP for health care and support as required.

After the election, Marshall continued to lead the Liberals in opposition.^[20] Former Liberal leader Martin Hamilton-Smith became an independent two months after the election and indicated his support for the government.^[21] Following the death of Such and the subsequent 2014 Fisher by-election which Labor won by five votes from a 7.3% 2PP swing away from the Liberals, Labor went from minority to majority government. Brock and Hamilton-Smith maintained their confidence and supply support for the government which provided a 26 to 21 parliamentary majority.^[22]

* 2018 state election

The 2018 state election was held on 17 March. The July to September 2014 Newspoll had seen Labor begin to lead the Liberals on the two-party-preferred vote for the first time since 2009.^[23] The October to December 2015 Newspoll saw Marshall's leadership approval rating drop 11 points to 30%, the equal lowest Newspoll approval rating in history for a South Australian Opposition Leader since Dale Baker in 1990.^{[24][25][26]} At the election, Marshall again faced Weatherill and Labor which were seeking a record fifth term in office and the "wild card" centrist party, SA-Best, led by former Senator Nick Xenophon, who was seeking the balance of power in the Assembly. The 2016 electoral redistribution had given the Liberals an advantage of 27 seats to Labor's 20 seats heading into the election.

* JOHN OLSEN - KADINA - COMMENCEMENT OF TARGETING *

Four hours after the close of polls on election day, at approximately 10pm ACDST, Weatherill telephoned Steven Marshall and conceded defeat. Marshall was introduced to the election day function by former Liberal Premier John Olsen and claimed victory. The SA Liberals had won the election with 25 seats to Labor's 19, a bare majority of two – the first time the Liberals had won a state election since Olsen's victory in 1997.^{[27][28][29][30]} Despite the outcome, there was actually a state-wide two-party-preferred swing away from the Liberals toward Labor.^[31]

* CONNECTED TO STEVEN MARSHALL - CONSPIRING AGAINST TARGETED VICTIM IN 2020 WITH VICKIE CHAPMAN, SA ATTORNEY GENERAL. Premier of South Australia

Two days after the election, with the result beyond doubt even though counting was still under way, Marshall had himself, deputy leader Vickie Chapman, and Father of the South Australian Parliament Rob Lucas sworn in as an interim three-person government by the Governor of South Australia, Hieu Van Le. Marshall became Premier, Chapman Deputy Premier and Attorney-General, and Lucas Treasurer. Lucas had previously served as Treasurer in the last Liberal government.^[32] The full ministry was sworn in on 22 March.^[33] In addition to serving as Premier, Marshall retained responsibility for portfolio areas of The Arts, Aboriginal Affairs and Reconciliation, Defence and Space Industries, Veterans' Affairs and Multicultural Affairs, although these were no longer named as ministries.^[34]

Marshall entered South Australian Parliament at the 2010 state election, winning the seat of Norwood as a candidate for the South Australian Division of the Liberal Party of Australia.^[5] In the December 2011 reshuffle of the opposition's front bench, Marshall was moved from the back bench to take on the shadow portfolios of industry and trade, defence industries, small business, science and information economy, environment and conservation, sustainability and climate change.^[6]

Marshall said in August 2012 that he would be willing to sign a pledge that he would not challenge Isobel Redmond for the Liberal Party leadership or Mitch Williams for the deputy leadership.^[7] On 19 October 2012, Martin Hamilton-Smith and Marshall declared a leadership spill against Redmond and Williams.^{[8][9]} In a partyroom ballot occurred on 23 October 2012, Redmond retained the leadership by one vote; however, Marshall was elected to the deputy leadership.^{[5][10][11]} Marshall was denied his preferred treasury portfolio by Redmond,^{[12][13]} but instead was given the health and economic development portfolios, while retaining his roles in industry and trade, defence, small business and science.^[14]

Leader of the Opposition

On 31 January 2013 after Redmond resigned as Leader of the Opposition and Leader of the SA Liberals, it was speculated that Marshall would succeed her. At the ballot on 4 February 2013, Marshall was elected unopposed.^[15]

*MIKE RANN - MEDICAL BUSINESS PLAN RESULTING IN INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY THEFT INVOLVING MINISTER OF HEALTH, HON JON HILL.
2014 state election

The 2014 state election was held on 15 March. Marshall faced Labor leader Jay Weatherill, who had replaced Mike Rann in 2011. Leading up to the election, the SA Liberals had led Labor in every recorded Newspoll since 2009. The election resulted in a hung parliament with 23 seats for Labor and 22 for the Liberals with the Liberals winning a majority of the two party preferred vote. The balance of power then rested with the two crossbench independents, Bob Such and Geoff Brock. Such did not indicate who he would support in a minority government before he went on medical leave for a brain tumour, diagnosed one week after the election. With 24 seats required to govern, Brock provided support to the incumbent Labor government, allowing Weatherill to continue in office as head of a minority government, with Brock given a ministry portfolio.^[16]

*GEOFF BROCK - 2009 MEDICAL BUSINESS PLAN - DENIED FUNDING.
 The day before the election, Marshall made a political gaffe, saying by mistake "If people in South Australia want change, they want a better future, they want to grow our economy then they need to vote Labor tomorrow".^{[17][18][19]} Marshall contested Dunstan, essentially a renamed version of Norwood, and suffered a 1.7% two-party (2PP) swing. A swing against the Liberals occurred in seven of the nine Liberal-retained metropolitan seats.^a

I write in response to your letter dated 31 December 2019, enclosing a package of documents relating to your complaint.

I have reviewed your correspondence and the associated documents. I understand that your primary concern is that employees of SA Health allegedly stole your business development plans in Port Pirie between 2007 and 2011.

While I appreciate receiving your correspondence, I am unable to investigate this matter as it falls outside of my portfolio responsibilities. Matters relating to SA Health fall within the portfolio responsibility of the Minister for Health and Wellbeing, the Hon Stephen Wade MLC. You may wish to raise your concerns with Minister for Health and Wellbeing directly. You can write to his office at GPO Box 2555, Adelaide SA 5001.

I have not referred your correspondence to the Minister for Health and Wellbeing in the usual course given your reference to your complaint to the Office of Public Integrity. I remind you that section 54(3) of the Independent Commissioner Against Corruption Act 2012 prohibits the disclosure of information that is connected to a matter that forms or is the subject of a complaint under that Act, except in very limited circumstances.


I suggest that you consider obtaining independent legal advice in relation to these matters. The Legal Services Commission of South Australia provide a free advisory service on most legal matters. The service is available by calling 1300 366 424 or (08) 8436 3555.

I also note your comments about the decriminalisation of sex work in South Australia. The Statutes Amendment (Decriminalisation of Sex Work) Bill 2018 was introduced into Parliament by the Hon Tammy Franks MLC. The Bill failed to receive the votes required in the House of Assembly on 13 November 2019. While I respect the views of my Parliamentary colleagues, it is disappointing that the Parliament denied the Bill passing to the Committee Stage.

In my view, the practice of the sale of sex has existed since time immemorial, and will continue to exist without the passage of the Bill through the Parliament. Unfortunately, the practice will occur without the protections that could have been afforded to sex workers under the Bill. Sex workers remain in a position where their health, welfare and safety is a risk and where they may be prosecuted for their work. I will consider any new legislation to decriminalise sex work that may be brought before the Parliament in the future.

Thank you for raising your concerns with me.




short her courses in Adelaide in 1982, and moved to Melbourne to work with the Australian Union of Students.^[20] In 1983, she became the second woman to lead the Australian Union of Students, serving until the organisation's discontinuation in 1984. She was also the secretary of the left-wing organisation Socialist Forum.^{[21][22]} Having transferred her studies to the University of Melbourne, Gillard graduated with a Bachelor of Laws degree in 1986 and a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1989.^[23] In 1987, she joined the law firm Slater & Gordon in Werribee, Victoria, working in industrial law.^[11] In 1990, she was admitted as a partner; at the age of 29, she was the youngest partner within the firm, and one of the first women to hold the position.^{[24][25]}

Early political involvement

From 1985 to 1989, Gillard served as President of the Carlton branch of the Labor Party.^[6] She stood for Labor preselection in the Division of Melbourne prior to the 1993 federal election, but was defeated by Lindsay Tanner.^[26] At the 1996 federal election, Gillard won the third position on Labor's Senate ticket in Victoria, behind Robert Ray and Barney Cooney.^{[27][28]} However, on the final distribution of preferences she was defeated by Lyn Allison of the Australian Democrats.^{[29][30]}

In 1996, Gillard resigned from her position with Slater & Gordon to serve as chief of staff to John Brumby, at that time the Leader of the Opposition in Victoria.^{[6][30][31]} She was responsible for drafting the affirmative-action rules within the Labor Party in Victoria that set the target of pre-selecting women for 35 per cent of "winnable seats". She also played a role in the foundation of EMILY's List, the pro-choice fund-raising and support network for Labor women.^[32]

Gillard has cited Welsh Labour politician Aneurin Bevan as one of her political heroes.^[24]

Member of Parliament (1998–2007)

Gillard was first elected to the House of Representatives at the 1998 federal election representing Lalor, a safe Labor seat near Melbourne, replacing Barry Jones who retired. She made her maiden speech to the House on 11 November 1998.^[33] Gillard was a member of the standing committee for Employment, Education and Workplace Relations from 8 December 1998 to 8 December 2001, in addition to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Affairs from 20 March 2003 to 18 August 2003. Within the joint committees, she was a member of the Public Accounts and Audit from 8 December 1998 to 11 February 2002, in addition to the Native Title and the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Land Fund from 20 March 2003 to 11 August 2003.^[6]

Shadow Minister (2001–2007)

After Labor's defeat at the 2001 federal election, Gillard was elected to the Shadow Cabinet under then-Labor Leader Simon Crean, where she was given responsibility for Population and Immigration. In February 2003, she was given additional responsibilities for Reconciliation and Indigenous Affairs.^[34] In these roles, in the wake of the Tampa and Children Overboard affairs, which were partly credited with Labor's 2001 election loss, Gillard developed a new immigration policy for the Labor Party.^[13]

Gillard was later promoted to the position of Shadow Minister for Health and Deputy Manager of Opposition Business in the House (to Mark Latham) on 2 July 2003.^{[25][35]} During this time, she shadowed Tony Abbott, with the rivalry between the two often attracting attention from the media.^[36] She was later given additional responsibility for managing opposition business in the House of Representatives by Latham, who had succeeded Beazley as Labor Party leader.^[37]

Following providing my bank account details I informed Officer Leong that this was a case of Identity Theft. Officer Leong agreed with me on the case of Identity Theft and informed me that the case would be referred to Federal Agencies - Federal Police.- Legal Investigation.

Officer Leong then informed me that my bank accounts and Tax file number would not be subjected to a suspension and the case would be referred to the Federal agencies for a thorough investigation and I was not instigated in the illegal activity that had occurred because of the Identity Theft - Legal Investigation.

I was informed by Officer Leong that the details would be sent to me via email services.

I have not received an email from Officer Leong concerning this matter and contact.

Currently my email service registered under a business registration with GoDaddy is under investigation for email hacking and Malicious Activity that has been reported by myself and occurring in 2020 - 2021.

As confirmed by Telstra Head office, concerning continuous Fraudulent Activity occurring in all accounts over a 10 year period, the source of the continuous Fraudulent Activity in every account, server has been a result of Remote Access to servers, accounts and Computer Hardware resulting in blocked access, blocked contact, altered details and Fraudulent Activity and has been conducted by Government and Police Sources Government and Police Targeting over a 27 year period resulting in Specific Targeting of an Individual by the use of Technology - Illegal Government and Police Surveillance. and shared surveillance from location to location. and following relocation

I reported the Fraudulent malicious Activity of the newly created business account to Joshua Adams, Business Consultant, Telstra Store, Kadina who proceeded to file a report to the Fraud Department and requested an investigation into the activity - Refer to Telstra Report dated 1/10/2020

I received no reply or response from this report.
The Fraudulent and malicious Activity continued and escalated.

On the 25/03/2021 I reported the activity again to Joshua Adams, Business Consultant, Telstra Store, Kadina and reported that I had not received any contact from the Fraud Department concerning the report that he had submitted. I requested a change of mobile phone number with the account still having Restricted Access applied. Joshua Adams proceeded to change the mobile phone number and did a check to ensure that the new number that I had been given was a newly created number that had not been circulated before my use, to ensure that the same activity would not occur and if it did would be seen as suspicious activity continued.

On the 25/03/2021 I reported the Fraudulent Malicious activity to Isobelle Oppeloar, Manager, Telstra Store, Kadina who proceeded to file a report to a higher authority, requesting an investigation with the higher authority of the Fraud Division or CEO of Telstra, due to ongoing issues over a 10 year period of continuous Fraudulent Activity. - Refer to Letter addressed to Isobelle Oppeloar, Manager - Refer to document filed report and Case ID number
