During his premiership Olsen had overseen the privatisation of South Australia's electricity system, the outsourcing of its water industry, and a number of development projects intended to boost the state's ailing economy. After the election, Marshall continued to lead the Liberals in opposition.<sup>[20]</sup> Former Liberal leader Martin Hamilton-Smith became an independent two months after the election and indicated his support for the government.<sup>[21]</sup> Following the death of Such and the subsequent 2014 Fisher by-election which Labor won by five votes from a 7.3% 2PP swing away from the Liberals, Labor went from minority to majority government. Brock and Hamilton-Smith maintained their confidence and supply support for the government which provided a 26 to 21 parliamentary majority.<sup>[22]</sup>

\* 2018 state election

The 2018 state election was held on 17 March. The July to September 2014 Newspoll had seen Labor begin to lead the Liberals on the two-party-preferred vote for the first time since 2009.<sup>[23]</sup> The October to December 2015 Newspoll saw Marshall's leadership approval rating drop 11 points to 30%, the equal lowest Newspoll approval rating in history for a South Australian Opposition Leader since Dale Baker in 1990.<sup>[24][25][26]</sup> At the election, Marshall again faced Weatherill and Labor which were seeking a record fifth term in office and the "wild card" centrist party, SA-Best, led by former Senator Nick Xenophon, who was seeking the balance of power in the Assembly. The 2016 electoral redistribution had given the Liberals an advantage of 27 seats to Labor's 20 seats heading into the election.

\* JOHN OLSEN - KADINA - COMMENCEMENT OF TARGETING \*

Four hours after the close of polls on election day, at approximately 10pm ACDST, Weatherill telephoned Steven Marshall and conceded defeat. Marshall was introduced to the election day function by former Liberal Premier John Olsen and claimed victory. The SA Liberals had won the election with 25 seats to Labor's 19, a bare majority of two – the first time the Liberals had won a state election since Olsen's victory in 1997.<sup>[27][28][29][30]</sup> Despite the outcome, there was actually a state-wide two-party-preferred swing away from the Liberals toward Labor.<sup>[31]</sup>

\* CONNECTED TO STEVEN MARSHALL - CONSPIRING AGAINST TARGETED VICTIM IN 2020 WITH VICKIE CHAPMAN, SA ATTORNEY GENERAL.  
Premier of South Australia

Two days after the election, with the result beyond doubt even though counting was still under way, Marshall had himself, deputy leader Vickie Chapman, and Father of the South Australian Parliament Rob Lucas sworn in as an interim three-person government by the Governor of South Australia, Hieu Van Le. Marshall became Premier, Chapman Deputy Premier and Attorney-General, and Lucas Treasurer. Lucas had previously served as Treasurer in the last Liberal government.<sup>[32]</sup> The full ministry was sworn in on 22 March.<sup>[33]</sup> In addition to serving as Premier, Marshall retained responsibility for portfolio areas of The Arts, Aboriginal Affairs and Reconciliation, Defence and Space Industries, Veterans' Affairs and Multicultural Affairs, although these were no longer named as ministries.<sup>[34]</sup>



Dear Ms Pearce

I write in response to your letter dated 31 December 2019, enclosing a package of documents relating to your complaint.

I have reviewed your correspondence and the associated documents. I understand that your primary concern is that employees of SA Health allegedly stole your business development plans in Port Pirie between 2007 and 2011.

While I appreciate receiving your correspondence, I am unable to investigate this matter as it falls outside of my portfolio responsibilities. Matters relating to SA Health fall within the portfolio responsibility of the Minister for Health and Wellbeing, the Hon Stephen Wade MLC. You may wish to raise your concerns with Minister for Health and Wellbeing directly. You can write to his office at GPO Box 2555, Adelaide SA 5001.

I have not referred your correspondence to the Minister for Health and Wellbeing in the usual course given your reference to your complaint to the Office of Public Integrity. I remind you that section 54(3) of the Independent Commissioner Against Corruption Act 2012 prohibits the disclosure of information that is connected to a matter that forms or is the subject of a complaint under that Act, except in very limited circumstances.


I suggest that you consider obtaining independent legal advice in relation to these matters. The Legal Services Commission of South Australia provide a free advisory service on most legal matters. The service is available by calling [Redacted] or [Redacted].

I also note your comments about the decriminalisation of sex work in South Australia. The Statutes Amendment (Decriminalisation of Sex Work) Bill 2018 was introduced into Parliament by the Hon Tammy Franks MLC. The Bill failed to receive the votes required in the House of Assembly on 13 November 2019. While I respect the views of my Parliamentary colleagues, it is disappointing that the Parliament denied the Bill passing to the Committee Stage.

In my view, the practice of the sale of sex has existed since time immemorial, and will continue to exist without the passage of the Bill through the Parliament. Unfortunately, the practice will occur without the protections that could have been afforded to sex workers under the Bill. Sex workers remain in a position where their health, welfare and safety is a risk and where they may be prosecuted for their work. I will consider any new legislation to decriminalise sex work that may be brought before the Parliament in the future.

Thank you for raising your concerns with me.



She was also the secretary of the left-wing organisation Socialist Forum.<sup>[21][22]</sup> Having transferred her studies to the University of Melbourne, Gillard graduated with a Bachelor of Laws degree in 1986 and a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1989.<sup>[23]</sup> In 1987, she joined the law firm Slater & Gordon in Werribee, Victoria, working in industrial law.<sup>[11]</sup> In 1990, she was admitted as a partner; at the age of 29, she was the youngest partner within the firm, and one of the first women to hold the position.<sup>[24][25]</sup>

### Early political involvement

From 1985 to 1989, Gillard served as President of the Carlton branch of the Labor Party.<sup>[6]</sup> She stood for Labor preselection in the Division of Melbourne prior to the 1993 federal election, but was defeated by Lindsay Tanner.<sup>[26]</sup> At the 1996 federal election, Gillard won the third position on Labor's Senate ticket in Victoria, behind Robert Ray and Barney Cooney.<sup>[27][28]</sup> However, on the final distribution of preferences she was defeated by Lyn Allison of the Australian Democrats.<sup>[29][30]</sup>

In 1996, Gillard resigned from her position with Slater & Gordon to serve as chief of staff to John Brumby, at that time the Leader of the Opposition in Victoria.<sup>[6][30][31]</sup> She was responsible for drafting the affirmative-action rules within the Labor Party in Victoria that set the target of preselecting women for 35 per cent of "winnable seats". She also played a role in the foundation of EMILY's List, the pro-choice fund-raising and support network for Labor women.<sup>[32]</sup>

Gillard has cited Welsh Labour politician Aneurin Bevan as one of her political heroes.<sup>[24]</sup>

## Member of Parliament (1998–2007)

Gillard was first elected to the House of Representatives at the 1998 federal election representing Lalor, a safe Labor seat near Melbourne, replacing Barry Jones who retired. She made her maiden speech to the House on 11 November 1998.<sup>[33]</sup> Gillard was a member of the standing committee for Employment, Education and Workplace Relations from 8 December 1998 to 8 December 2001, in addition to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Affairs from 20 March 2003 to 18 August 2003. Within the joint committees, she was a member of the Public Accounts and Audit from 8 December 1998 to 11 February 2002, in addition to the Native Title and the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Land Fund from 20 March 2003 to 11 August 2003.<sup>[6]</sup>

### Shadow Minister (2001–2007)

After Labor's defeat at the 2001 federal election, Gillard was elected to the Shadow Cabinet under then-Labor Leader Simon Crean, where she was given responsibility for Population and Immigration. In February 2003, she was given additional responsibilities for Reconciliation and Indigenous Affairs.<sup>[34]</sup> In these roles, in the wake of the Tampa and Children Overboard affairs, which were partly credited with Labor's 2001 election loss, Gillard developed a new immigration policy for the Labor Party.<sup>[13]</sup>

Gillard was later promoted to the position of Shadow Minister for Health and Deputy Manager of Opposition Business in the House (to Mark Latham) on 2 July 2003.<sup>[25][35]</sup> During this time, she shadowed Tony Abbott, with the rivalry between the two often attracting attention from the media.<sup>[36]</sup> She was later given additional responsibility for managing opposition business in the House of Representatives by Latham, who had succeeded Beazley as Labor Party leader.<sup>[37]</sup>







Vickie Ann Chapman (born 21 June 1957) is an Australian politician, representing the South Australian House of Assembly seat of Bragg for the South Australian Division of the Liberal Party of Australia since the 2002 election. Chapman served as the Deputy Premier of South Australia and Attorney-General between 19 March 2018 and 22 November 2021 in the Marshall government.<sup>[1]</sup> She was the first woman to hold either post.

Chapman has previously served as deputy leader of the Liberal Party from 2006 to 2009, and became deputy leader again in 2013. In that capacity, she served as Deputy Leader of the Opposition between 30 March 2006 and 4 July 2009, and again between 4 February 2013 and 19 March 2018. She was also the Shadow Attorney-General and Shadow Minister for State Development, having gained the extra portfolio of State Development in a cabinet reshuffle on 13 January 2016.



## Early life

Chapman was born on Kangaroo Island. One of seven children, Chapman attended the Kangaroo Island Parndana Area School, and following the death of her mother at age 12, she later attended Pembroke School in Adelaide. She studied a law degree at the University of Adelaide and graduated in 1979 as a barrister.

Chapman's father, Ted, was a member of the Liberal and Country League and then the South Australian Division of the Liberal Party of Australia in the South Australian House of Assembly. A Liberal moderate, Ted was a member of the Steele Hall-led Liberal Movement faction in the 1970s and





The CFS website shows the Duncan fire has now extended over the entire 13,000 hectare north coast fire warning area.

The scrub fire is uncontrolled and is burning in a northerly direction towards the coast between Middle River and Snug Cove. Conditions are continually changing.

SA Police will be undertaking assessments of damaged properties around Western River and Western River Cove today. Assessments of properties around Middle River cannot commence until fire conditions moderate

\* Crews on Sunday afternoon, December 22, are continuing to work on the Coopers Road, Duncan fire on Kangaroo Island where 13,000 hectares have been burnt.

Overnight back burning has secured part of the western edge of the Duncan fire, however the area between Snug Cove on the coast and Snug Cove Road approximately 2km south of the coast remains unsecured at this time.

The CFS is implementing its plans to secure the western edge of the fire using a retardant line, but due to smoke causing poor visibility this is proving to be difficult.

Plans are also being made to secure the southern edge of the fire, north of the Playford Highway.

Two teams of firefighters from the mainland are working with local crews, private farm firefighting units, the forestry industry and crews from the Department of Environment and Water.

To ensure your safety, and that of firefighters and other emergency personnel, please do not enter the area unless necessary. Hazards may include reduced visibility due to smoke, fallen trees blocking roads and emergency vehicles operating in the area.

Residents in the area are advised to remain vigilant and to continue checking and following your Bushfire Survival Plan.

I write in response to your letter dated 31 December 2019, enclosing a package of documents relating to your complaint.

I have reviewed your correspondence and the associated documents. I understand that your primary concern is that employees of SA Health allegedly stole your business development plans in Port Pirie between 2007 and 2011.

While I appreciate receiving your correspondence, I am unable to investigate this matter as it falls outside of my portfolio responsibilities. Matters relating to SA Health fall within the portfolio responsibility of the Minister for Health and Wellbeing, the Hon Stephen Wade MLC. You may wish to raise your concerns with Minister for Health and Wellbeing directly. You can write to his office at GPO Box 2555, Adelaide SA 5001.

I have not referred your correspondence to the Minister for Health and Wellbeing in the usual course given your reference to your complaint to the Office of Public Integrity. I remind you that section 54(3) of the Independent Commissioner Against Corruption Act 2012 prohibits the disclosure of information that is connected to a matter that forms or is the subject of a complaint under that Act, except in very limited circumstances.

I suggest that you consider obtaining independent legal advice in relation to these matters. The Legal Services Commission of South Australia provide a free advisory service on most legal matters. The service is available by calling [redacted] or [redacted]



I also note your comments about the decriminalisation of sex work in South Australia. The Statutes Amendment (Decriminalisation of Sex Work) Bill 2018 was introduced into Parliament by the Hon Tammy Franks MLC. The Bill failed to receive the votes required in the House of Assembly on 13 November 2019. While I respect the views of my Parliamentary colleagues, it is disappointing that the Parliament denied the Bill passing to the Committee Stage.

In my view, the practice of the sale of sex has existed since time immemorial, and will continue to exist without the passage of the Bill through the Parliament. Unfortunately, the practice will occur without the protections that could have been afforded to sex workers under the Bill. Sex workers remain in a position where their health, welfare and safety is a risk and where they may be prosecuted for their work. I will consider any new legislation to decriminalise sex work that may be brought before the Parliament in the future.

Thank you for raising your concerns with me.



short her courses in Adelaide in 1982, and moved to Melbourne to work with the Australian Union of Students.<sup>[20]</sup> In 1983, she became the second woman to lead the Australian Union of Students, serving until the organisation's discontinuation in 1984. She was also the secretary of the left-wing organisation Socialist Forum.<sup>[21][22]</sup> Having transferred her studies to the University of Melbourne, Gillard graduated with a Bachelor of Laws degree in 1986 and a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1989.<sup>[23]</sup> In 1987, she joined the law firm Slater & Gordon in Werribee, Victoria, working in industrial law.<sup>[11]</sup> In 1990, she was admitted as a partner; at the age of 29, she was the youngest partner within the firm, and one of the first women to hold the position.<sup>[24][25]</sup>

From 1985 to 1989, Gillard served as President of the Carlton branch of the Labor Party.<sup>[6]</sup> She stood for Labor preselection in the Division of Melbourne prior to the 1993 federal election, but was defeated by Lindsay Tanner.<sup>[26]</sup> At the 1996 federal election, Gillard won the third position on Labor's Senate ticket in Victoria, behind Robert Ray and Barney Cooney.<sup>[27][28]</sup> However, on the final distribution of preferences she was defeated by Lyn Allison of the Australian Democrats.<sup>[29][30]</sup>

In 1996, Gillard resigned from her position with Slater & Gordon to serve as chief of staff to John Brumby, at that time the Leader of the Opposition in Victoria.<sup>[6][30][31]</sup> She was responsible for drafting the affirmative-action rules within the Labor Party in Victoria that set the target of pre-selecting women for 35 per cent of "winnable seats". She also played a role in the foundation of EMILY's List, the pro-choice fund-raising and support network for Labor women.<sup>[32]</sup>

Gillard has cited Welsh Labour politician Aneurin Bevan as one of her political heroes.<sup>[24]</sup>

## Member of Parliament (1998–2007)

Gillard was first elected to the House of Representatives at the 1998 federal election representing Lalor, a safe Labor seat near Melbourne, replacing Barry Jones who retired. She made her maiden speech to the House on 11 November 1998.<sup>[33]</sup> Gillard was a member of the standing committee for Employment, Education and Workplace Relations from 8 December 1998 to 8 December 2001, in addition to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Affairs from 20 March 2003 to 18 August 2003. Within the joint committees, she was a member of the Public Accounts and Audit from 8 December 1998 to 11 February 2002, in addition to the Native Title and the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Land Fund from 20 March 2003 to 11 August 2003.<sup>[6]</sup>

## Shadow Minister (2001–2007)

After Labor's defeat at the 2001 federal election, Gillard was elected to the Shadow Cabinet under then-Labor Leader Simon Crean, where she was given responsibility for Population and Immigration. In February 2003, she was given additional responsibilities for Reconciliation and Indigenous Affairs.<sup>[34]</sup> In these roles, in the wake of the Tampa and Children Overboard affairs, which were partly credited with Labor's 2001 election loss, Gillard developed a new immigration policy for the Labor Party.<sup>[13]</sup>

Gillard was later promoted to the position of Shadow Minister for Health and Deputy Manager of Opposition Business in the House (to Mark Latham) on 2 July 2003.<sup>[25][35]</sup> During this time, she shadowed Tony Abbott, with the rivalry between the two often attracting attention from the media.<sup>[36]</sup> She was later given additional responsibility for managing opposition business in the House of Representatives by Latham, who had succeeded Beazley as Labor Party leader.<sup>[37]</sup>

**Amir Raz, assistant professor of clinical neuroscience at Columbia University, offers the following answer.**

\* Definitely. Radiation is energy and research findings provide at least some information concerning how specific types may influence biological tissue, including that of the brain. In some cases the effect may be therapeutic. For example, transcranial magnetic stimulation (TMS) is a technique used to induce a short-term interruption of normal activity in a relatively restricted area of the brain by rapidly changing a strong magnetic field near the area of interest. Mark George provided a nice account of TMS in the September 2003 issue of *Scientific American*. In it he described how head-mounted wire coils can deliver powerful yet evanescent magnetic pulses directly into focal brain regions to painlessly modulate neural activity by inducing minute electric currents. Clinically, TMS may be helpful in alleviating certain symptoms, including those of depression.

Researchers typically differentiate between the effects of ionizing radiation (such as far-ultraviolet, X-ray and gamma ray) and nonionizing radiation (including visible light, microwave and radio). The ionizing variety may be undesirable because it can cause DNA damage and mutations, thus we should all limit our exposure to its sources--radioactive materials and solar radiation among them. However, given modern technology, nonionizing radiation from power lines, personal wireless devices, cell phone towers and other sources is practically unavoidable. Extremely

Unfortunately, at least some of these studies fail to meet many of the criteria for good research, thus weakening their scientific value further. Therefore, more well-controlled studies are required to validate conclusions as to whether exposure to cell phones influences cognition, especially in the long term. Nevertheless, most of the reported effects are small as long as the radiation intensity is within the reasonable nonthermal range and its duration does not exceed common exposure for users.

In 2002 the U.K. published a brochure recommending that children and young people should use cell phones as little as possible. A year later Thailand's interior minister considered a ban on their use by children. But in 2004 the Health Council of the Netherlands, unable to find convincing scientific data demonstrating a difference between children and adults in the absorption of electromagnetic energy, found no reason to recommend limiting child use.

I was unaware of solid scientific evidence to support such concerns, but given that my cell phone was one of my infant son's favorite toys, I let him play with it only after I made sure it had been switched off. A precautionary approach remains justifiable because detrimental effects cannot be ruled out completely. Now that my son has learned how to turn my phone back on, however, I remind myself that when these phones are used in public, the indirect health effects sustained by vexed passersby may well outweigh the direct neural disturbances on their users.

Still, a very recent report associates increased risk of malignant brain tumor with long-term cell phone use. This report does not represent a new study but is instead a combined analysis of two population-based case control studies published in 2003 and 2005. The findings from this report are difficult to interpret because the experimental design is notably different from that of previous studies of long-term cell phone use and brain cancer. For example, the exposure assessment was mostly performed using mailed questionnaires; multiple confounding factors were not addressed, and a single statistical adjustment corrected for the year of diagnosis only. In addition, a compelling mechanism of action is absent and it is unclear what
