Your complaint will be allocated to an Assessment Officer within the OPI who will be responsible for your matter under my supervision. During the assessment process you may be contacted by the OPI to clarify issues or to provide further information and documentation to assist the OPI in making its assessment.

In some circumstances, the OPI may need to contact other agencies or persons to obtain further information to assist in the assessment process. Please note that this process can take some time.

Your matter will be assessed pursuant to section 23 of the *Independent Commissioner Against Corruption Act 2012* ('ICAC Act') and a determination made as to whether or not action should be taken to refer the matter or to make recommendations to the Independent Commissioner Against Corruption ('Commissioner').

Please be aware that an assessment is **not** an investigation.

An investigation may only take place if the matter is assessed as raising a potential issue of corruption, misconduct or maladministration in public administration, or raises some other issue that should be referred for investigation. That investigation cannot be undertaken by the OPI because the ICAC Act does not provide the OPI with that function.

The action that can be taken in respect of a matter is governed by section 24 of the ICAC Act.

If your matter is assessed as raising a potential issue of corruption in public administration, the matter may be investigated by the Commissioner or be referred to the South Australia Police, the Police Ombudsman or other law enforcement agency.

If your matter is assessed as raising a potential issue of misconduct or maladministration in public administration, your matter may be referred to an inquiry agency (being the South Australian Ombudsman or the Police Ombudsman) or to a public authority for investigation.





I am contacting you today to report a suspected Security Breach in my Origin electricity account.

I had previously contacted you in 2015 to inform you of suspected fraudulent activity in my account concerning an excessive rise in billing, but I did not receive a reply.

Recently I have investigated this matter in the Kadina Post Office service and have discovered that the bar code for payment supplied on the billing was not an Origin electricity account barcode but rather scanned as Townsville, CC Parking Fines Department, Queensland.

I have reported this suspected fraudulent activity to I.C.A.C, whom begun a review and investigation into matters of corruption, involving numerous areas of my accounts and including Police involvement / Targeting.

I have attached an Optus report that has incurred suspected fraudulent activity, which also incurred excessive billing over a long period of time.

I am contacting you today concerning a report that I had sent 16th March 2016 , of which I had received no reply.

This report refers to a suspected Security Breach of my account involving excessive billing, fraudulent activity and suspected fraud / Angel, representative, whom was organising payment plans during the time of excessive billing.

Further to this information I have also reported suspected fraudulent activity in other utility accounts, including a Security Breach and excessive rise in billing in an origin electricity account.

Recently I have discovered by using the services of the Kadina Post Office that the barcode on my utility account was not of Origin electricity origin , but rather Townsville, CC Parking Fines, Queensland.

I have also included a copy of an ANZ bank account record of a Telstra withdrawal of my account.

This was reported to the ANZ manager of Port Pirie as a Security Breach of my account and is registered on their system.

Telstra had illegally accessed my bank account and illegally withdrew money without my knowledge or consent. I was not a Telstra customer at the time of this withdrawal and am reporting this as suspected fraudulent activity of my Telecommunications systems and am requesting an investigation into this matter.



I refer to Mr Stroud's letter to you dated 23 December 2016 which acknowledged receipt of your complaint and outlined the process followed in relation to your complaint by the Office for Public Integrity (OPI) and Independent Commissioner Against Corruption (the Commissioner).

The Commissioner has asked me to inform you of his determination pursuant to section 24 of the *Independent Commissioner Against Corruption Act 2012* (ICAC Act).

\* An assessment of your complaint has been undertaken and the material provided by you in your eight emails dated 23 and 24 December 2016 has been carefully considered.

\* Your complaint concerns the conduct of South Australian public authorities and public officers, as well as various members of the public and private organisations.

\* The jurisdiction of the ICAC Act is limited to issues concerning public administration in South Australia. Therefore, many of the individuals and organisations to which you refer do not fall within the Commissioner's jurisdiction and no action can be taken by this office in relation to those issues.

\* You have made a number of allegations in relation to South Australia Police officers, the Regional Development Board, Port Pirie Primary School, the Port Pirie Fines and Recovery Unit, the Legal Profession Conduct Commissioner and Members of Parliament.

\* Having considered the information provided the Commissioner has accepted the OPI's assessment that the matter fails to raise a potential issue of corruption, misconduct or maladministration in public administration.

The IIS will assess your complaint and decide whether further action is required. The OPI oversees this process. Complaints and reports assessed by IIS may be re-assessed by the OPI.

Further action may be taken if the complaint or report is assessed as raising a potential issue of corruption, misconduct or maladministration in public administration, or a breach of discipline. For further explanation of how your complaint or report might be assessed, please refer to the factsheet.

Dear Ms Pearce

Thank you for your complaint to the Office for Public Integrity (OPI) of 3 February 2022 in which you allege that various government agencies and non-government organisations have engaged in money laundering, computer hacking, sexual crimes, intellectual property theft and corruption.

You also explain that you were detained at [REDACTED] based on a false diagnosis and that SACAT wrongly ordered you to [REDACTED]. You say that Members of Parliament were involved in or had influence over the SACAT order.

The OPI has reviewed the information you provided and assessed your complaint in accordance with the *Independent Commission Against Corruption Act 2012* (ICAC Act). The ICAC Act provides that the OPI may determine to refer a complaint or report to another agency for further assessment or to take no further action.

While I acknowledge that the experiences you describe have been distressing for you, I do not think that there is sufficient information available to support the allegations to justify a referral to another agency for further assessment.

In light of the above, I have determined to take no further action in respect of your complaint pursuant to section 18E(1)(c) of the ICAC Act.

As no further action will be taken, I will now close the file.
