The Miami Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) requests the assistance of the Australian Federal Police (AFP) in delivering a Victim Notification Letter and brochure to [REDACTED] [REDACTED], date of birth [REDACTED], who has been contacted in the past at [REDACTED] - [REDACTED] and/or [REDACTED].

On 24 July 2006, the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Palm Beach Resident Agency (PBCRA) opened an investigation involving the illegal sexual activity between multi-millionaire Jeffrey Epstein and minor aged children. At the conclusion of the sexual activity, the minors were paid sums of money ranging from \$200.00-\$1,000.00. Testimony from multiple witnesses indicate hat [REDACTED] [REDACTED], a minor at the time, was one of Jeffrey Epstein's victims. Mr. Epstein is believed to have had contact with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] during the years of 1998/99 - 2003/04. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] is a dual citizen US and Australian citizen. Under United States Code Title 18 Section 3771, a victim of a crime in the United States has a number of rights which are detailed in the enclosed letter and brochures. It is requested that the Australian Federal Police locate [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and deliver the enclosed letter and brochure.
