After being advised of the identity of the interviewing agents and the nature of the interview, [REDACTED] provided the following information: [REDACTED] advised that she began working as a personal assistant to JEFFREY EPSTEIN in [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was an event planner and had her resume on [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. She was interviewed by JEFFREY EPSTEIN, GHISLAINE MAXWELL and KIMBERLY FOLEY for the position. Her current job responsibilities include scheduling EPSTEIN's personal and business appointments, answering e-mails and organizing/planning EPSTEIN's day. EPSTEIN's office is located at 457 Madison Avenue, New York, New York, telephone [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] described EPSTEIN as a good boss. [REDACTED] confirmed [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was employed by EPSTEIN. According to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] works as EPSTEIN's travel assistant. The interview was interrupted when [REDACTED] attended to her child and when she received incoming telephone calls. After the final call she accepted, [REDACTED] requested to speak with an attorney at which point the interview was concluded. The agents then served [REDACTED] with a Federal Grand Jury subpoena.
