Because of new law, when JE travels abroad it is considered an abroad day and not a US day up to 30 days

I believe a day that Jeffrey travels from the U.S. to France will still count as a U.S. day (and if from New York, a New York day). Likewise on the return. The distinction as I understand it is now up to 30 days in which he is neither in the U.S. nor the V.I. will be considered V.I. days
