

Lawn Doctor Hybrid Plus Program

Hybrid Program: Stage 1 – We apply fertilizer to help promote an early spring green up and recover from winter stress. We also apply a custom 1 application pre-emergent for season long crabgrass control. We will apply broad leaf weeds control as needed.

Hybrid Program: Stage 2* – We will continue to improve your lawns color with a treatment with a custom organic fertilizer. Broad leaf weeds will become active at this time and we will be treating them accordingly.

Hybrid Program: Stage 3* – Summer conditions may stress and weaken your lawn. We start to apply a special blend of organic fertilizers to give the soil and turf important nutrients to minimize any damage. We also check for weeds and surface insects and treat accordingly.

Hybrid Program: Stage 4* – We will continue to apply a special blend of organic fertilizer to help the lawn recover from any stress due to summer conditions. We will also treat for weeds accordingly. **Hybrid Program: Stage 5*** - This is a special blend of organic fertilizers to help encourage new root growth and assist in thickening the lawn. We will continue to check for weeds and treat them accordingly.

Hybrid Program: Stage 6* – This important fall organic fertilizer strengthens the root system for winter survival and supplies important nutrients for an early spring green up. We also check for weeds and treat accordingly.

Preventative Grub Protection – The control we use provides long residual protection against these subsurface insect, it should be applied early to protect your lawn against the threat of grubs.

Lime – Restore the pH Balance of your soil. When soil pH is controlled with lime, nutrients are made available, allowing fertilizers to work efficiently to provide long lasting, deep green lawns.

INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT

Lawn Doctor encourages the maintenance of healthy landscapes through integrated pest management (IPM), and we use only organic based fertilizers. LAWN DOCTOR CAN PROTECT YOUR TREES AND SHRUBS

Like your lawn, your plantings need protection from insects and diseases, which can create extensive damage in a single growing season. Lawn Doctor has the training, equipment and know-how to deliver the care that enhances your plantings health and beauty.

Here is what we recommend:

Spring Horticultural Oil – This is an environmentally friendly protective coating. It treats plantings for insects and their eggs, which would otherwise hatch, just in time to prevent attack on vulnerable new growth.

Spring Inspection and Treatment – Mid March through late April is the most active time for hatching insects (Adelgids, Aphids), fungus diseases (Leaf Spot, Anthracnose) and other damaging diseases. This is also a good time to review cultural practices.

Late Spring Inspection and Treatment – Late May through June is when chewing and sucking insects become more active (Spider Mites, Aphids, Bag worms, lace bugs). Our technicians treat for these conditions and inspect cultural conditions including watering and mulching practices that may enhance or damage plant growth.

Summer/Early Fall Inspection and Treatment – August through September is when insects and diseases are still active and can cause serious damage to plantings.

Fall Horticultural Oil – As winter approaches, a second treatment of Oil is applied to treat for remaining insects and help to prepare plantings for winter. Our technicians review cultural practices including mulching and pruning.

Tick Control Program Description

Early Spring Application (March – May)

This application is aimed at eliminating the adult and nymph stages of the tick life cycle by targeting areas which both adults and nymphs dwell.

Late Spring Application (May – June)

Nymphs and adults may still be active and this is the time that many of the over-wintering eggs start hatching. This is a critical point in controlling the population for the year.

Summer Application (June – August)

Ticks attach themselves to many of the animals that are common on your property. When deer, chipmunks, mice, squirrel's, etc. walk across your property ticks may drop off. This treatment will control those ticks before they can start to invade your property.

Fall Application (September – November)

Eliminate active adult ticks and eggs that have been deposited. The fall is when the adult female tick lays her eggs for the following spring. This treatment is important in the life cycle because it will affect the tick population on your property for the spring and summer of the following year.

TICK CONTROL INFORMATION

Due to the probability of tick re-infestation, multiple applications are usually necessary. A four-treatment program is designed to coincide with various stages of the tick life cycle. Applications are scheduled at peak times, in an effort to achieve optimum results on your property. In addition to tick treatments, there are several things you can do to help reduce tick populations. Your main focus should be the reduction of tick habitat. This can be accomplished by cleaning up debris in and around your lawn. All woodpiles should be removed, weeds and grass should be mowed and no leaf piles should be allowed to sit. Keep perimeter areas adjoining your lawn clean and well mowed to help create a buffer. In some situations, adding a 3-foot wide landscape border around the perimeter of your lawn using mulch or landscape rock can help.

Research on control of ticks is ongoing. Research has shown by using registered products at the proper time, that tick populations on properties can be reduced by 68-97 percent. Treating with an insecticide does not guarantee that ticks will not be present. People still need to protect themselves by dressing appropriately, using repellents when in potentially tick-infested areas and checking daily for the presence of ticks.

Grub Control



GRUB CONTROL

Grubs are the larval stage of several beetles. During their lifecycle, they exist approximately two inches below the lawn's surface, continuously feeding on the root system. Proactively treat your lawn for grubs with Lawn Doctor's Preventative Grub Control.

Grub damage is most likely to occur in the late summer and early fall months. However, grubs can also be present and cause damage in the late spring. Grub activity will encourage damage due to scavenging animals including moles, skunks and birds, all of which will search for grubs to feed on. Damage may not be apparent until it is too late, requiring costly repair.

Lawn Doctor can provide the best treatment to help prevent damage before it occurs. Lawn Doctor's Preventative Grub Control is just what the doctor ordered.

Lime Application



LIME APPLICATION

Turf grass is ideally grown in slightly acidic soil, which is measured by the pH level. The optimum pH range for lawns is 6.5 to 7.0. Balanced pH is necessary for plants to receive proper nutrients that help maintain lawn health and vigor. When soil becomes too acidic or alkaline, nutrients that grass plants need to thrive become unavailable, resulting in unhealthy turf. To ensure maximum nutrient availability and correct pH, Lawn Doctor recommends applying lime.

Lime helps restore the physical condition of soil, providing you with the following benefits:

- Increases fertilizer effectiveness: When soil pH is controlled with lime, nutrients are readily available, allowing fertilizers to work better.
- Reduces thatch: Lime slows the growth of the thatch layer, which becomes a barrier to air, water and fertilizer. Lime encourages microbial action that breaks down thatch.
- Reduces fungus problems: Proper pH levels promote favorable growing conditions, encouraging healthy plants that are less susceptible to damage caused by disease.
