- AREAS AND LARGE CITIES. THE POTENTIAL FOR VIOLENCE BY TERRORISTS AND OTHER CRIMINAL ELEMENTS EXISTS IN ALL PARTS OF THE COUNTRY.
- B. THERE HAS BEEN A MARKED INCREASE IN VIOLENT CRIME IN COLOMBIA. MURDER RATES HAVE RISEN SIGNIFICANTLY IN SOME MAJOR CITIES, PARTICULARLY MEDELLIN AND CALI. KIDNAPPING REMAINS A SERIOUS THREAT. COLOMBIA REQUIRES THAT MINORS (UNDER 18), REGARDLESS OF NATIONALITY, WHO ARE TRAVELING ALONE, WITH ONE PARENT OR WITH A THIRD PARTY, PRESENT A COPY OF THEIR BIRTH CERTIFICATE AND WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION FROM THE ABSENT PARENT(S) OR LEGAL GUARDIAN, SPECIFICALLY GRANTING PERMISSION TO TRAVEL ALONE, WITH ONE PARENT OR WITH A THIRD PARTY.
