Below is the list of the documents I would need for the french embassy, I am applying for both: regular Schengen (for Paris) and french overseas territories (St. Barth), so I put the dates for both. My appointment is on Monday, Aug 31st, so I would need everything ready by then. Please let me know if you have any questions.

1. Flights

Complete **personal** itinerary or round trip ticket with confirmed dates. Open tickets are not accepted. **JUST BOOK your trip but DO NOT PURCHASE your tickets until the visa has been approved.**

Paris: September 10th (arrival) - September 20th(departure)

St. Barth: December 25th (arrival) - January 10th(departure)

2. Hotels

Confirmed and **personal** reservation from the hotel(s) in France and in the Schengen countries to be visited and which must be sent directly to you and not to the Consulate, confirming your reservations for each night you will spend in France and the Schengen States (we do not accept emails confirmations),

or
personal hotel vouchers confirming your booking for a tour with names and addresses of all hotels with the number of nights stay in each (**+ 1 copy**),

Paris: Bristol hotel Sept 10th-Sept 20th

St. Barth: any hotel Dec 25th - Jan 10th

3. Medical insurance

A **letter** from an insurance company (**+ 1 copy**) stating that you will be covered for any **medical, hospitalization and repatriation** expenses (the three words must be written) for at least \$45,000 during your stay in the Schengen countries. If your current insurance company does not provide such a coverage, please find an international insurance company (**and ask for the letter** mentioned above with the three words).
