Made change to indicate proper name of STC on all three documents. They forgot to add the “, Inc.” at the end of the name in each of the documents. See my mark-ups attached. I did not verify any personal information about the women on any of the documents. They should do that. As to whether the substance of the letters/documents is acceptable, the best thing to do would be to submit them to the Japanese visa service company and make sure that the Visa service company pre-approves them before Joi’s people send them to us in final. This is what we did with the Russian Visa Company who, it turns out, made some necessary changes. Given that Joi’s people have not done this before, it makes sense to get pre-approved by the visa service company.
