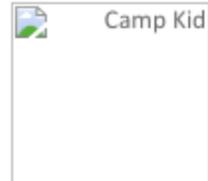

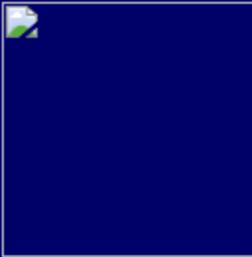
## Dutch Total Soccer

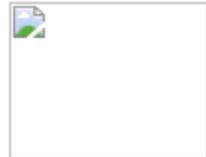

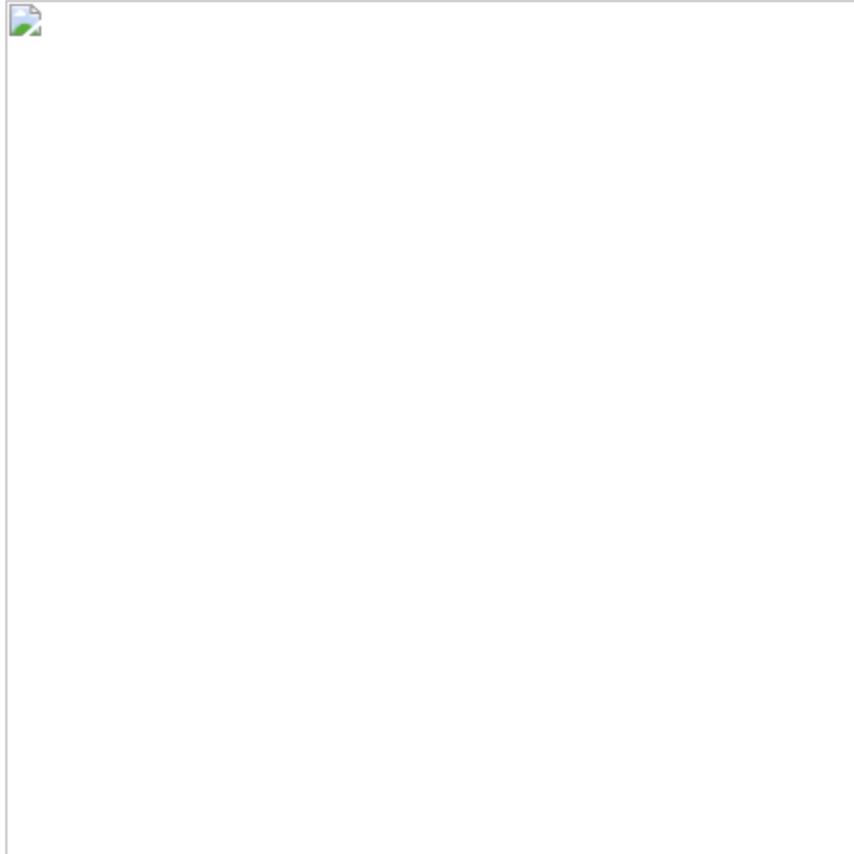

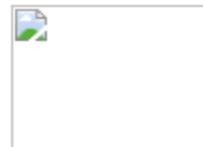
