



Information on Hungarian legislation and technologies relating to electronic invoicing.

- The attachment is the original invoice, which is issued in an electronic format by Wizz Air Hungary Ltd. In accordance with Hungarian legislation in force (Act XXXV of 2001 on Electronic Signatures; Act C of 2000 on Accounting and Ministry of Finance Decree 46/2007 on the Rules of Electronic Invoicing) companies are entitled to issue electronic invoices.
- The attached electronic invoice fully complies with the provisions of Act CXXVII of 2007 on Value-Added Tax as it includes the images displayed in the ordinary invoices issued by Wizz Air Hungary

Ltd., the electronic signature and time-stamp which have been created by using enhanced security Public Key Infrastructure (PKI) technology.

- The electronic signature displayed on the electronic invoice is an electronic signature with improved security, which together with the time-stamp has been certified by the service-provider with a "Qualified Business Certificate" for the request of Wizz Air Hungary Ltd. The electronic invoice also includes the certificate used for the verification of the signature and the time-stamp, and all the information required for verification.
- The recipient shall preserve the electronic invoice in the electronic format, similarly to paper-based invoices, if used for accounting purposes.
