The key to these is not simply using mental math to solve the equations, but showing the inverse operation and checking the solution, like this video shows: <http://virtualnerd.com/middle-math/equations-functions/solving-addition/subtraction-example>. There should be other videos like this on Google classroom from previous homework assignments.
