Town Council Unanimously Approves \$151 Million Town Budget


After months of intense negotiations, the 2018-2019 New Canaan town budget is finally a done deal. The New Canaan Town Council on Thursday unanimously approved a total town operating budget of \$150,939,170, an increase of 1.89 percent, or \$2,794,676 compared with the current budget of \$148,144,503.
