Donation Guidelines

We cannot accept: clothing, footwear, or mattresses, Christmas and holiday decorations (except high-end collectibles), children's car seats, electronics, TV, or CRT monitors, computers, printers, appliances, sleep sofas, office desks or large file cabinets, large pieces like entertainment centers, armoires, and hutches unless they are in great shape, Outdated exercise equipment, plumbing and bath fixtures, building materials, luggage **except** very clean sports bags, anything that is unsalable (too worn, too big, obsolete).
