1. If you haven't already, please submit via mail or online (it's much easier online...) the photo you want for yearbook by JANUARY 15. It's free! A few people have asked which photo to choose so to clarify, pick the photo with you in a robe (no cap, scroll, hands in photo). I've attached the photo [REDACTED] using for reference. The studio will be sending the yearbook company all the photos in one package so if you don't have your yearbook photo selected by January 15, you unfortunately won't have your headshot in the yearbook.

2. Please e-mail your 'thank you' blurb to [REDACTED] by January 30! The limit is 120 words. If we don't receive anything by then, the generic message of "Thank you everyone." will be used for your yearbook page. (That's what they used in the past)

3. Also, start gathering photos for your collage! This will also be due January 30. I've attached an image what each individual's yearbook page will look like. Use [REDACTED] to make your collages.

Detailed instructions regarding collage:

Go to [REDACTED] —> click 'Make a Collage' —> click on 'Classic' icon at the top left (right under the Fotor icon) because those have the collage layouts you can use (you're welcome to use any one) —> click 'Open' in the center top of the screen to upload any photos you want to use (Use high resolution images so the images don't come out blurry/grainy and the yearbook software will reject low quality images) —> Organize your photos! —> Save your collage (make sure you select 'highest quality') —> Email to [REDACTED]

4. Chair partner SELFIES are also due by January 30! A few people have sent non-selfie partner portraits; although they are wonderful pictures, we would love to follow the selfie trend. See attached image of Ryan and Bobby.

-DUE JAN 30: 1) Thank you blurb 2) Collage 3) Chair-partner selfie —> Everything can be sent to [REDACTED]

-No extensions because everything is very time-sensitive!
