**Understanding Your Quote**

**PRICE** - Price is based on the items, services, locations, and other information provided by the customer and typed in this estimate. Additional or less items and/or services will change the price accordingly. **MINIMUM** - Hourly based moves - 3 hours; Volume based moves - 250 cf; Weight based moves - 1750 lbs. **PACKING** - Ben Hur will pack and or protect all items listed in the inventory, except for items marked PBO (Packed By Owner). **DISMANTLING AND REASSEMBLY** - Ben Hur will dismantle and reassemble tables, regular beds, and dresser's mirrors. All other dismantling and reassembly must be specified in writing in this estimate, otherwise an additional charge will be applied. **FURNITURE PROTECTION** - Ben Hur will protect all furniture as needed. **INVENTORY** - A complete itemized inventory is part of Ben Hur service in the following moves: into storage; consolidated; and interstate (excluding NY commercial zone). On all other moves inventory is not included. **DELIVERY** - Exclusive Service: same day or as otherwise specified in this estimate. Consolidated Service: up to 1400 miles - up to 10 business days from the earliest requested delievry date; up to 20 business days from the earliest requested delievry date; or as otherwise specified in this Estimate or Order for Service. Reimbursement rate for lateness is \$25 per day. **TOLLS** - unless included in this estimate, local tolls, and muni-meter are to be paid by the customer. **MOVE LIABILITY (VALUATION) Interstate** - WARNING: If a moving company loses or damages your goods, there are 2 different standards for the company's liability based on the types of rates you pay. (1) **Value-Protection (FVP)** Full Value Protection - Under Full Value Protection, your mover is liable for the replacement value of lost or damaged goods in your entire shipment. This is the more comprehensive plan available for the protection of your belongings. Unless you select the alternative level of liability described below—Released Value—your mover will transport your shipment under the Full Value Protection level of liability. If any article is lost, destroyed or damaged while in your mover's custody, your mover will, at its discretion, offer to do one (1) of the following for each item: Repair the item, Replace with a similar item, Make a cash settlement for the cost of the repair or the current market replacement value. Under this option, movers are permitted to limit their liability for loss or damage to articles of extraordinary value, unless you specifically list these articles on the shipping documents. An article of extraordinary value is any item whose value exceeds \$100 per pound (i.e., jewelry, silverware, china, furs, and antiques). Ask your mover for a written explanation of this limitation before your move. The exact cost for Full Value Protection varies by mover and may be subject to various deductible levels of liability that may reduce your cost. Ask your mover for written details of their Full Value Protection plan. (2) **Released**

**Value (RV)** - Released Value - The most economical protection available is Released Value, since it is offered at no additional charge. However, the protection is minimal. Under this option, the mover assumes liability for no more than 60 cents per pound per article. For example, if your mover lost or damaged a 10-pound stereo component valued at \$1,000, you would only receive \$6.00 in compensation (60 cents x 10 pounds). There is no additional charge for Released Value. However, you must sign a specific statement on the bill of lading or contract agreeing to it. But remember, it compensates you according to the weight of the item, not its actual value. And, if you do not select Released Value, your shipment will automatically be transported at the Full Value Protection level of liability and you will be assessed the applicable charge. Full Value Protection and Released Value are not insurance policies governed by State insurance laws; instead, they are Federal contractual tariff levels of liability authorized under Released Rates Orders of the Surface Transportation Board of the U.S. Department of Transportation. **MOVE LIABILITY (VALUATION) New York - Released Value (RV)**: of 30 cents per lb. per article for hourly rate moves within New York State and 60 cents per lb. per article for binding price moves within New York State (Compensation is based on the actual or estimated weight of the item/s). **Value-Protection (FVP)** is available at \$5 per \$500 of declared value - Minimum valuation is \$2,500; Maximum valuation is \$5,000; Deductible \$250 applies. (In case of loss or damage Ben Hur will repair, replace with a similar item or make monetary payment based on the current market value of the item/s). Unless otherwise indicated in this
