I just spoke with the gate agent and asked if there was anyway they could possibly hold the flight a few minutes if necessary since its the last flight to Jackson and he said no, if they are ready to go, they have to go. Lets hope it gets delayed even further. They just changed the departing gate to B77. You are landing at gate B90. When you get off the plane, take a left, you will come around a corner and go up a small escalator, walk through a corridor, and when you come around the corner, gate B77 will be immediately on your right. I just walked it and it took me about 2.5/3 minutes at a fast walk. I think you could do it in 1.5 minutes ;-)

Hey Darling,

I'm trying to make my next leg. It's delayed. It says we will get into Denver around 7:07PM. (United 3635, STL-DEN) The plane we are taking has left Chicago and is on the way here but hasn't landed yet. We are suppose to take off at 6:40PM Central.

Which is may be too late to make the Jackson Flight (United 4872, DEN-JAC) unless they will hold the door a couple minutes which will be up to you to make happen. It is the last flight for that plane and wouldn't effect anyone else as there are no connections afterwards. This should be your argument when your pleading with them.

My backup is to take the flight from Denver to Idaho (United 6538, DEN-IDA, landing at 11:27PM) then I will drive over.

Ideally try to convince them to hold the DEN to JAC flight a few minutes, as it will not effect anyone else negatively, it's the last flight.

Thanks honey and I will keep all of you posted!
