"Conclusion on the hypothesis 2 Is undeniable that some structural bosses and remote structures that are found in MEGA they could suggest some people that such elements could have been built for intelligent beings with even unknown objectives. Nevertheless, it is necessary to obtain more data before being able to do interpretations more insurances of the nature of the objects observed to the present. This hypothesis assumes that said structures were built in land sign. To be valid such possibility, then signifies that MEGA had to be emerged in the past, and turns out to be crucial to determine when MEGA submerged in the sea to establish the antiquity of the culture hypothetically related to these structures. The certain thing is that convincing and more precise data are needed to accept this hypothesis.

Third hypothesis: Are natural megalithic structures that eventually were utilized by intelligent beings This hypothesis is a combination of the two previous. It suggests that MEGA is a natural structure, that in a passed time could be emerged, and that given its geometric characteristics with aspect of bedrooms and running, could have been adapted for intelligent beings for its use with some housing or mystical purpose. Thus the coexistence of evidently natural structures would be explained linked to geological failures and displacements of blocks in the Strait of Yucatan, and certain very peculiar megalithic remote formations, that could suggest a cultural utilization. How Test validate it of these hypothesis? To clarify validate it of the relative hypothesis al origin of the structures of the region of MEGA is necessary to carry out more detailed investigations with the following objectives: 1. Determining if the zone of MEGA was emerged in the past, and if was it, when sank in the sea 2. Cartografiar in greater detail the region of MEGA and its outskirts, to determine its dimensions and details of its structure interior 3.
