

BORANA
LAIKIPIA PLATEAU | KENYA



Borana Lodge is very private, so you will not be overwhelmed by crowds or game park rules. We have a fleet of custom-built four wheel drive vehicles, so our extraordinary driver/guides will get you up close and personal for a very intimate view of wildlife. One of the best ways to see wildlife is on a guided bush walk.

Again the guides are superb and have extensive knowledge of the Bush and its ways which adds a rich dimension to each hike. If you like some serious exercise, take one of our mountain bikes for a spin. We guarantee a lot of stunning scenery, herds of plains game and a few sections of sharp descent making this an adventure to remember.

Borana Lodge lies on the edge of the Samangua Valley offering stunning panoramic views of Mount Kenya, across the Lewa Plains to the Ngare Ndare Forest. The lodge was built in 1992 by local artisans using indigenous building materials and dead wood found on the property. The result is a supremely comfortable and luxurious lodge, totally in keeping with its surroundings as if grown organically from the rocks on which it was built.



In a valley which meanders out of the Laikipia Plateau onto the Samburu plains of Northern Kenya, there is a retreat available only to the very few. This remote paradise is surrounded by a private ranch, which has been devoted to the conservation of its wildlife and its natural habitat.

Privacy is paramount at Borana Lodge. Each cottage is tucked into the landscape to capture its own special view, totally secluded from its neighbor. As a result, guests have a chance to experience both the wildness and solitude of Africa. Comforts abound, including a central eating and sitting area

with inviting leather sofas surrounding a huge fireplace with picture windows looking onto the valley below. Wonderful meals are served at a massive rosewood table in the dining room. There are fresh vegetables and produce from the farm, freshly squeezed juices from our orchard and fine wines from around the world.





OL MALO

NORTHERN FRONTIER DISTRICT | KENYA

Ol Malo, meaning “the place of the Greater Kudu,” is Colin and Rocky Francombe’s home. The 5,000-acre ranch and game sanctuary, lies along the Uaso Nyiro River along the edge of Kenya’s North East Province. It overlooks the Mukogodo, home of the nomadic Ndorobo people, with views that unveil the very face of Africa.

Days at Ol Malo are as full or unruffled as guests prefer. Picnics and sun downers in the bush; day and night game drives in rugged land cruisers; escorted walks for bird and game viewing; interesting treks with camels; visits to a colorful Samburu Manyatta (village); or an afternoon of sun and relaxation at pool side.



Colin & Rocky Francombe are both children of Kenya. Colin’s father arrived in Kenya in 1927 and as an early East African aviator, he became renowned as one of the best bush pilots in the country. Colin and Rocky spent 21 years of their married life on Ol Ari Nyiro Ranch, owned by Kuki Gallmann, author of “I Dreamed Of Africa.” Colin developed the property into a prime cattle and sheep ranch, as well as a wonderful sanctuary for wild animals including the endangered black rhino, which numbers nearly 50 animals. Rocky has been by his side every inch of the way. They are amazing hosts living in a pristine part of Africa where they share their unusual lives, stories and experiences with a few fortunate guests.



Built of natural rock with thatched roofs, Ol Malo is shaped by the rocks and the curve of ancient olive wood. The separate living area and dining room, each with an open fireplace for the cool evenings, have large windows overlooking a magnificent valley. There are four double guest houses discreetly nestled between rocks on cliffs overlooking a much-frequented water hole and salt lick, surrounded by miles of rugged wilderness. Each has an en-suite bathroom and a private veranda surrounded by gardens of indigenous plants and green lawns. The infinity pool is gorgeous as well where you will feel as if you’re swimming in the clouds.

LEMARTI'S CAMP

LAIKIPIA PLATEAU AREA, KENYA

Lemarti's Camp is an unforgettable safari hideaway in Kenya's breathtaking northern Laikipia Plateau, one of the last frontiers of virgin wilderness and home to the majestic Samburu people. The twist here is that while the local Samburu community owns the land, the camp itself was built and run by a local Samburu guide - Loyapan Lemarti - and his Kenyan-based fashion designer wife, Anna Trzebinski. This unlikely duo met on safari - he was her guide - and were later married. Their dream camp emerged, nestled in an oasis in a spectacular setting beneath a grove of palms and centenary fig trees.



Anna and Lemarti own two other camps, a Nomadic Camp that is pitched seasonally and a romantic Stargazing Camp by a river.

Anna designed every inch of this gorgeous property both inside and out. It's in her genes - her mom is an interior designer and her dad is an architect. The camp is open and alluring; both visually and physically connected to the incredible magic of the African bush. All of the rich and colorful furnishings were designed by Anna and handmade by local artisans. There are no set itineraries here. Guests can stay in bed until noon or leave before daybreak to take in the spectacular ornithological paradise. Guests are encouraged to interact with the land and the amazing Samburu people who call it home.



What is truly unique about staying at Lemarti's Camp is experiencing the "Rites of Passage" safari that Lemarti has crafted. It is an experience unparalleled in East Africa today. No safari vehicles or armed guards here. Guests quite literally walk into the wilderness with Samburu warriors armed only with their traditional weapons, their sharp senses and generations of knowledge. These gentle tribesmen will talk with you about their ways, connect you with amazing wildlife and take you into a moment in time that is both authentic and other worldly.

COTTARS 1920'S CAMP

COTTARS CONCESSION, MARA AREA | KENYA

The Cottars Safari tradition began in 1919 and for more than 80 years they have been providing an unparalleled safari experience to discerning clients. Cottars Safari Service is legendary for its level of luxury and attention to detail, re-creating the golden age of "safari" – an era of romance, professional guiding, adventure, and elegance.



The Cottars 1920's Safari Camp accommodates up to twelve travelers in authentic white canvas tents. Each is spacious and luxuriously furnished with original circa 1920's safari antiques, a private en-suite dressing room and bathroom (with shower and flushing toilet), a main bedroom, and an outdoor veranda.



This legendary camp is ensconced in 250,000 acres held by a community of 3,000 Maasai in the remote area of the Olentoro Hills, just outside the boundary of the Mara Game Reserve. This area is pristine, untouched by any kind of tourism or development and offers exquisite privacy. You will feel as if you have been transported back in time, especially when you are served afternoon tea from silver poured into china by a waiter kitted out in a crimson fez and vest over a full length Swahili tunic. Come nightfall, candles and lanterns are lit and the Cottars' magic continues.

Our Concession is situated in the only part of the Masai Mara where your privacy can be ensured and where you will never see tourists and minibuses. Since the camp is located outside the game parks, our trained trackers will take you on guided walks where you will be close to nature and experience wild game tracking safely and beautifully. There will also be opportunities for exciting night drives in the conservancy. And we have a full-time masseuse at camp, so if you feel like a bit of pampering – massages, manicures or pedicures are available. Our camp butlers have been trained to provide discreet, yet attentive service.

OL DONYO WUAS

CHYULU HILLS | KENYA

The newly-rebuilt Ol Donyo Wuas is owned by safari legend, Richard Bonham and is located in the Chyulu Hills, between Tsavo National Park and Amboseli National Park on over 275,000 acres. It is beautifully maintained and has a comfortable and exclusive ambiance.



Guests can enjoy walks and horseback trips on the plains, game drives in open-top vehicles which provide a great opportunity to enjoy the natural surroundings up close. Morning picnics or sundowners are all the more spectacular thanks to the presence of Mt. Kilimanjaro. The diverse habitat provides a wide range of wildlife including antelope, oryx, gerenuk, zebra, topi, impala, eland and wildebeest.



Ol Donyo Wuas Lodge is a 22 bed eco-lodge in the heart of the Mbirikani Maasai conservation area on the slopes of the Chyulu Hills near Amboseli National Park. Based on the foundations of the original, legendary Ol

Donyo Wuas, the recently re-built cottages all have stunning views of Mount Kilimanjaro, efficient solar powered lighting, and solar heated showers in the en suite bathrooms, and feature a décor that is both modern and luxurious as well as rustic and comfortable in the tradition of the great wilderness lodges.

Imagine...275,000 acres of wild Africa teeming with wild animals all to yourself, and no tourists in mini buses. Imagine travelling across the famous golden plains of Kenya in an open 4x4 safari vehicle guided by the best professional guides, or feeling the rhythm of Africa beneath your feet as you walk with expert trackers, or ride beautiful horses with Mt. 
NGONG HOUSE

Your host, Paul Verleysen, moved to Africa from Belgium in 1970. He has worked in the Congo, Rwanda, the Ivory Coast and finally Kenya where he bought a hunter's home and transformed it into Ngong House - a private, serene and luxurious retreat situated in the Karen / Langata area of Nairobi. The lodge overlooks the Ngong Hills, only a few minutes away from what used to be Karen Blixen's vast coffee farm. "I had a farm in Africa, at the foot of the Ngong Hills," she wrote.



Ngong House is beguiling and tranquil. Five rustic tree houses nestle almost invisibly into a landscape of thorn trees, cactus and acacia offering delicious privacy, pampered service, and gorgeous views of the undulating Ngong Hills.



Guests can enjoy sundowners by the fire, candlelit meals in the voluptuous dining room, and private drivers/guides for excursions to Nairobi's museums, markets and wildlife sanctuaries. Or you can choose to relax and dine on your lovely verandah watching breathtaking sunsets over the Ngong Hills and flocks of birds that descend on the bird feeder hanging just in front of your tree house.

Built entirely from wood with traditional African grass roofs, the tree houses are on stilts with two levels; a bedroom area upstairs- replete with a four poster - and a living area on the lower floor. Each house is raised 15 feet from the ground so guests will have an uninterrupted view of the Ngong Hills over unspoiled bush. They are designed with elegant comfort in mind yet the interiors have a decidedly rustic feel. Regional artists have added many of the finishing touches, such as hand woven rugs, bed covers, lamps and beautiful stained glass.

KENYA

The great safari land of Kenya is without doubt the stuff of legend, not just for their mighty tribes and proud warriors, or the intrepid explorers and fearless pioneers of days gone by, but also the magnificence of their landscape and wildlife.

Kenya is located on the East Coast of Africa, astride the equator. It is truly a land of contrasts; comprising arid desert, rich savanna land, mountains, large lakes and dense forests. The coastal area along the shores of the Indian Ocean has tranquil beaches, turquoise waters and a wealth of history established by early Arab and Portuguese traders.

PEOPLE

There are more than 40 tribes in Kenya, the most distinct being the Masai and Samburu. These tribes are still found in rural areas, dressed in their traditional style, living a relatively nomadic life, tending herds of cattle. It is interesting to note that these people have been integrated into a developing industrial nation without having to relinquish tribal customs and values.

WEATHER

Because Kenya is located on the equator, there are no extremes in the seasonal temperatures and there is little humidity. The elevation of Nairobi is 5,500 feet with the most of your safari conducted at elevations of 4,500 feet or higher. The nights are cool, averaging 50 to 60°F, with highs ranging from 70 to 90°F. The rainy season is from April to May, with some short rains in November. The coolest months are July-August, and the warmest months are late December to mid-March. The coast is warm and often humid, with a steady breeze.



VISA REQUIREMENTS

Currently, US Passport holders require a visa for both Kenya and Tanzania. Non-US Passport holders should check requirements.

TRAVEL TIPS TO KENYA

Best time to travel to Kenya is from June to October and again from December to March. The rainy season months are November, April and May.

The medical coverage of travel insurance policies is supplemental, meaning it reimburses you for whatever amount your primary health insurance doesn't cover. An excellent supplement to travel medical insurance is the services offered by Medjet Assist, an air-ambulance company that flies members to whatever medical facility they choose if they are hospitalized on a trip abroad and require further hospitalization.
 - **War & Terrorist Threat:** War or the "threat" of a terrorist act is not covered, for example: 1) If you decide to cancel your plans because of a "threat" at your specific destination, you will not be covered. 2) if a terrorist incident/violence occurs within 30 days of your scheduled arrival, then you are covered.
 - **Weather:** You are protected if you are forced to cancel due to inclement weather that causes an airline to ceased operations. Note: In order to recover any money from a vacation canceled for weather-related reasons, the insurance policy must have been purchased before the storm appeared on the weather map.
