F	----	Reserved; not shown.
G	400	Spur, northeastern peninsula from Road E
H	800	Mid-island connector Road A to Road E
I	1,200	Refined existing path, Caretaker to middle-top
J	1,000	Northwestern peninsula, avoids archeological site
