In regard to your March 5, 2010 correspondence, please understand that we will not be providing any photographs of [REDACTED]. She was taken to Jeffrey Epstein's home in 2005 by [REDACTED]. She was only told she would have to give an old guy a massage. She was taken to Jeffrey Epstein's bedroom and left alone. Mr. Epstein appeared nude and told her to give him a massage.

During the massage, Mr. Epstein touched her in a sexual manner. [REDACTED] then warned him not to do that again; despite the warning, while masturbating with one hand Mr. Epstein grabbed her again in a sexual manner. She abruptly ended the "massage", and he told her to get out. She has not sought medical or psychological treatment. Let me know if and when you would like to discuss this case within the next 7 days.
