You make a good point in regards to future repairs,

Your B727 has always presented one off repair issues, since we are converting analog to digital info for the EFIS flight displays, currently installed. The past 15 years hasn't posed many repair issues, we would typically would have to send our converter box for repair, since off the shelf boxes dont exist.

We carry a spare MFD EFIS tube on board the plane now, box replacement is easy,

I would imagine we would get good support from Rockwell Collins, but off the shelf replacement boxes would delay repairs, since special software was written for a 3 engine aircraft application.

However display tubes may be generic, however I'm not sure where the software installation comes into play.

I'll ask Neil at Banyan his opinion on this issue.
