As you know, this week the IIE-SRF Iraq Project is holding its 11<sup>th</sup> training conference- the 5<sup>th</sup> in Iraq.

Allan is with the team and provided a keynote today, and he had an interview with the press.

The IIE-SRF Iraq team (Nada, Celeste, Janet, Jessica, and Celine) have done yet another astounding job organizing this major event. Other IIE Divisions are involved as well.

Nada provided this update:

- The conference was officially opened by the U.S. Counsel General in Erbil Paul Sutphin
- The CG and the KRG-MOHE Minister Dr. Ali Saeed both provided opening remarks at the conference in which they emphasized the importance of these academic gatherings in promoting educational exchanges and mutual understanding between the American and the Iraqi people
- Over 160 Iraqi scholars and university-reps are in attendance at the conference including: 100 SRF scholars, and 62 university-reps from Iraq prime and the KRG
- SRF scholars traveled from 12 countries as well as from different cities in Iraq to attend the conference
- 32 Iraqi universities are participating in this conference including the following universities from Iraq prime:
