speed test average 16 up and 16 down, please see attached

Usage around 30 to 40 GB, but there's slight issue with transitioning devices from MH network to RC network

I think it would safe to say 50 to 60 gb would be a regular usage.

Both have the same SSID and password, will probably need Bob Picknell to check Ruckuss AP settings

Overall there have only been 2 outage. i just reset equipment and all was good

My one complaint is the Router has limited functionality ie, it indicates which device is on the network and but not device bandwidth utilization.

.Do you have issue with getting a Verizon Static ip and using Adtran router programmed for verizon with back up program for the T1

If Verizon service went down it would be an easy transition and I would be able to keep an eye on data utilization.


