




Born in Clondalkin, a suburb of Dublin, **Norton's** first big TV appearance was as Father Noel Furlong in *Father Ted*. He secured a prime time slot on Channel 4 with his chat shows *So Graham Norton* and *V Graham Norton*. He has hosted *Strictly Dance Fever*, Andrew Lloyd Webber's *How Do You Solve A Problem Like Maria*, the *Eurovision Song Contest* and the *BAFTAs*, in addition to winning 7 BAFTAs himself. He also presents a show on BBC Radio 2 every Saturday and writes, as Agony Aunt, weekly in a column for The Telegraph. So it's a wonder he has time to get personal for the *How to Academy*. Tonight, Norton is trading places: the lightning-tongued presenter of The Graham Norton Show will open up about his own hidden lives...

Alice Levine is a radio and TV presenter. For the past 2 years she has hosted the BBC Radio 1 afternoon weekend slot. Alice is also the co-creator of the No.1 comedy podcast sensation *My Dad Wrote a Porno* (the third series of which is out soon). Since its inception, the show has received 50 million downloads worldwide, garnered many celebrity fans including Elijah Wood, and remained Number 1 in the iTunes Podcast Chart for much of 2016. Alice also founded the *Jackson & Levine supper club* alongside fellow presenter, Laura Jackson. Their first book together, *'Round To Ours'* will be published on May 18th.
