


The results are in...but what now? The historic decision made by 51.9% of the British public for the United Kingdom to leave the European Union has left many wondering what the future holds.





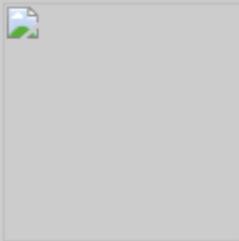
