Mr. Epstein, If possible, the following message requires immediate attention. I am the COO, Exec VP and Program Director for a new air ambulance program being formed in St. Thomas with bases planned for both the southern and western Caribbean. As you may be aware, lives in the US Virgin Islands as well as the entire Caribbean Basin are unnecessarily at risk daily. When someone in the Virgin Islands or frankly anywhere in the Caribbean is ill or injured, they must wait hours and sometimes even days for an air ambulance to arrive from the continental United States. Our company AAC - Air Ambulance Caribbean, LLC through its DBA "Flight 4 Life" will be filling an enormous void by providing rotor wing air ambulance services in the US Virgin Islands and fixed wing turboprop and jet air ambulance services in the Virgin Islands as well as the remainder of the Caribbean. Upon disbursement of funds, Alliance Warburg will transfer the principal of \$552,500.00 plus interest of \$110,500.00 to you for a total of \$663,000.00.
