**Latest points on Saudi, Pak, Yemen:**

**Status:**

- Parliamentary debate on Pak involvement in Yemen war will continue today;--Not a single Member of Parliament has spoken in favour of Pak boots on the ground;
- PM Sharif has refused to disclose details of his "understanding" with the Saudis, so far refuses to make a pronouncement on whether Pak will join the Regional Coalition; calling instead on Iran (whose Foreign Minister arrives in Pak today 8 April, to be involved in the talks on Yemen security (I cannot imagine him making this comment on his own, but who knows);
- PM also is waiting for response from Turkish President on a joint shuttle diplomacy, Turkish Foreign Minister expected any day in Islamabad;
- Meanwhile, the new Saudi kid on the block, 30 year old Saudi Prince Mohammad is visiting Ankara this week, Turkish Foreign Minister visiting Iran;
- references to Pak troops being part of a UN Security-Council mandated PK force;
- many in Pakistan are no longer buying into the Sunni Saudi versus Shiite Iran story;
- 1 Senator asked that China as a P5, be involved via UN Sec Council;
- idea to convene special session of OIC;
- yesterday 7 April, Egyptian Army Chief paid surprise visit to Pak Army Chief to discuss Yemen;

**Under the radar:** concern over 2 million Pak workers in Saudi whose remittances add to the National Exchequer; plus on the Pak-Iran Gas Pipeline Agreement; US State Dept has approved Pak request to purchase US\$ 1 billion worth of high-tech arms & military hardware to fight insurgency (including combat aircraft such as attack helicopters – earlier this year, US handed over to Pak Army weapons, ammo & other sophisticated military equipment which had been used by ISAF in Afghanistan).
