Dear Jeffrey,

this is a difficult issue for me to ask. I have asked Martin about the cost of living in Boston; he suggested that about 100K would be necessary to keep the family fed. Is that somehow possible, please? (Our normal burn rate in Berlin is about 5000 Euro/month, which is about \$82K/year, and I gather that Boston is quite a bit more expensive.)
