I have attached our Hurricane evacuation protocol. This has all the information needed for staying in the marina during a storm. From the nights that are not occurred during the storm the charge will be \$2.00 per foot per night.

Hey Bossman,

Subbase Dry Dock said that Big N have to leave the storage/repair area this afternoon due to Hurricane Irma.

I've been speaking with Liza from Crown Bay Marina (across from SBDD) to see if they can fit us into their storage area. Liza is working on it and should have more info on storage fee in about an hour

Our only other option is for Carlos to take it to Virgin Gorda this afternoon but I don't think the Barge is capable of that run due to bad weather, worn seals on steering shaft, water going into the engine room and Hydraulic fluid leaking. The cut off date to deliver Big N to VG Dry Dock is Monday morning.
