I began my Foundation as a means of saying how do we replace this extremism based on a perversion of religion that is all over the world, with an idea of faith that is respectful of difference.

"I have an ambition to link thousand schools in the USA to schools in Muslim countries. What we are doing works. We have got to show people we have got a better idea than the extremists have – to learn from each other and live with each other."
