The F1000 SmartSearch will help you discover the papers you need to know about for your research. First, seed your search with a cluster of articles that most closely match your interests, then interact with the results to tell F1000 SmartSearch whether the articles returned are relevant or not, and after a few rounds of results and interactions, the tool will learn your preferences. The most on-target articles recently published will then be delivered to you by email and to your desktop.

If your previous access has expired, write to us and we will re-instate a 6-week complimentary subscription for you to try out this new tool.

After this period, you can either purchase a personal subscription or recommend F1000 to your librarian.
