About hereditary breast cancer and BRCA

Breast and ovarian cancers are cancers that affect women. Some of them are hereditary, passed down from generation to generation.

Hereditary cancer can happen when a parent (male or female) has a gene mutation and passes it down to their son or daughter. The most common are BRCA1 and BRCA2 gene mutations.

- **If women have the BRCA gene mutation,** it increases their risk of breast and/or ovarian cancer.

- **If men have the BRCA gene mutation**, it increases their risk of breast and/or prostate cancer.
