>  
> fantastic results  
>  
> data already show for the 100m alone that knee symmetry predicts running  
> speed—and knees are the most symmetric of the three variables measured—the  
> effect size is large  
>  
> feet are completely irrelevant and while ankles of sprinters are  
> significantly more symmetrical in elites vs controls, there is only a weak  
> and insignificant signal from ankle symmetry, as in our earlier work  
>  
> no symmetry effects expected for 400m and none found—though we do expect a  
> strong association with 100 vs 400 in 2nd:4th digit ratio, the work that  
> Jeffrey originally helped finance in 2010—we shall see very shortly  
>  
> meanwhile we have a host of other categories which will only add strength  
> to our analysis, 100 and 110 hurdles etc
